

FROM THE DESK OF THE PRESIDENT



Dear members of the Bishop Ward community,

Looking ahead to next year, we at Bishop Ward plan for all students to learn in-person every day.

Looking back at last year, the difficult year of 2020, we completed the final quarter online-only in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. The consensus in May 2020 was that online-only was not succeeding, and we needed to do everything we could to get all students back in the classroom.

As the summer wore on, however, and the pandemic did not cease, public health officials urged caution, and the local health department was resisting students' return to school. We at Bishop Ward pushed back, and though we were not allowed to bring all of our students to school in person, we have had students in school all year, mostly in a hybrid arrangement.

Much like at this time last year, educators and parents are recognizing the limitations of online learning. Simply put, we need to get back to in-person learning, as it is best for all our students and takes full advantage of the professional skills of our excellent faculty.

I want to be clear: it is our intent for the coming year to return to normal and have all in-person learning for the whole year from day one. We know we can go online if need be, and snow days may never again be the same, but our students need all the benefits that come with being with their peers and their teachers on a daily basis.

Even during the peak of the pandemic, spreading of the virus here in school was never in evidence. Sports teams successfully competed throughout the year and continue to do so. We had to quarantine at times, but we never had clear contact tracing of virus spread in school. When our faculty and staff were allowed to get vaccinated, we took full advantage of it. In recent months, the Centers for Disease Control lightened restrictions for schools because their data showed what we knew from experience: school was a safe place to be.

With all that has happened, we are proud of our students, notably our seniors, whom we love and will miss. We are very proud of their record-setting achievements with 26 Hispanic Development Fund scholarships, 17 KC Scholars scholarships, and a total of nearly \$2.5 million in college scholarships, well over \$30,000 per student on average.


We are grateful to work with your students and to partner with you in raising them to be the Christian leaders our community needs. Please let me know if you have any questions regarding our path forward.

DE LA OFICINA DEL PRESIDENTE



Estimados miembros de la comunidad de Bishop Ward:

Mirando hacia el próximo año, en Bishop Ward planeamos que todos los estudiantes aprendan en persona todos los días.

Mirando hacia atrás al año pasado, el año difícil de 2020, completamos el último trimestre en línea, solo en respuesta a la pandemia de Covid-19. El consenso en Mayo de 2020 fue que el uso exclusivo en línea no estaba teniendo éxito, y necesitábamos hacer todo lo posible para que todos los estudiantes volvieran al salón.

Sin embargo, a medida que avanzaba el verano y la pandemia no cesaba, los funcionarios de salud pública instaron a la precaución y el departamento de salud local se resistió al regreso de los estudiantes a la escuela. Nosotros en Bishop Ward retrocedimos, y aunque no se nos permitió traer a todos nuestros estudiantes a la escuela en persona, hemos tenido estudiantes en la escuela todo el año, principalmente en un arreglo híbrido.

Al igual que en esta época, el año pasado, los educadores y los padres están reconociendo las limitaciones del aprendizaje en línea. En pocas palabras, debemos volver al aprendizaje en persona, ya que es lo mejor para todos nuestros estudiantes y aprovecha al máximo las habilidades profesionales de nuestra excelente facultad.

Quiero ser claro: es nuestra intención para el próximo año volver a la normalidad y tener todo el aprendizaje en persona durante todo el año desde el primer día. Sabemos que podemos conectarnos en línea si es necesario, y es posible que los días de nieve nunca vuelvan a ser los mismos, pero nuestros estudiantes necesitan todos los beneficios que conlleva estar con sus compañeros y sus maestros a diario.

Incluso durante el pico de la pandemia, la propagación del virus aquí en la escuela nunca fue evidente. Los equipos deportivos compitieron con éxito durante todo el año y continúan haciéndolo. A veces tuvimos que ponernos en cuarentena, pero nunca tuvimos un rastreo claro de contacto de la propagación del virus en la escuela. Cuando a nuestra facultad y personal se les permitió vacunarse, lo aprovechamos al máximo. En los últimos meses, los Centros para el Control de Enfermedades aligeraron las restricciones para las escuelas porque sus datos mostraban lo que sabíamos por experiencia: la escuela era un lugar seguro para estar.

Con todo lo que ha sucedido, estamos orgullosos de nuestros estudiantes, especialmente de nuestros estudiantes de último año, a quienes amamos y extrañaremos. Estamos muy orgullosos de sus logros récord con 26 becas del Fondo de Desarrollo Hispano, 17 becas KC Scholars y un total de casi \$2.5 millones en becas universitarias, más de \$30,000 por estudiante en promedio.



Enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year began February 2021!

Timeline

February: Enrollment paperwork arrived in your home. This included a financial agreement and enrollment agreement. **Only one financial agreement is needed per family.**

To apply for financial aid, visit online: [factsmgmt.com.aid](https://factsmgmt.com/aid). Enrollment Fees are due to the Business Office. Enrollment fee is \$150 per student. **Students will not be able to choose classes with a counselor until enrollment fees and all documents have been submitted.**

Please turn in financial agreement to the business office and enrollment agreement to Mrs. Sanchez in the front office.

April: Tuition letters were sent to homes.

June 15: First tuition payment for the 2021-2022 school year is due.

- ◇ **Students will not be allowed to pick out classes until families have re-enrolled with the Business Office.**
- ◇ **All school fees need to be paid by 8/4/21 in order for your student to receive a school schedule.**

Dress Code Reminders for Outerwear and Uniform Pants for 2021-2022

From Mr. Ridley, Dean of Students:
Bishop Ward Outerwear Policy

General Guidelines

IMPORTANT:

—Girls' Skirts: In order to maintain modesty guidelines, as found in the Handbook, **the hem of the girls' skirts may not be more than 3 inches above the knee.** It is also important that the girls do not roll their skirts. If the skirts are more than 3 inches above the knee, girls will be asked to wear uniform slacks.

—Girls' Slacks: Only khaki dress slacks are acceptable for girls. A maximum of four pockets (2 in front and 2 in back) are permitted. Cargo, skinny, or stretch slacks are not permitted. Shorts are not permitted for girls.

—Boys' Slacks: Only khaki dress slacks are acceptable. Slacks may have a maximum of four pockets (2 in front and 2 in back). Cargo, skinny, or stretch slacks are not permitted.

—Boys' Shorts: Only khaki dress shorts are acceptable. The khaki shorts should not have more than four pockets (2 in front and 2 in back). Shorts should be hemmed and should be knee length.

—**Shirts for Girls & Boys:** Both boys and girls must wear the black uniform polos with the school crest on the left. Only plain white, grey or black undershirts can be worn under the uniform polos. Uniform polos with the BWHS logo can be purchased through the school. Please contact Mrs. Martinez at 913-371-6814 or email her at kmartinez@wardhigh.org to get information on school shirts.

Outerwear:

Bishop Ward students are only allowed to wear school-approved outer wear over their school uniform polo for warmth. Students must still wear a uniform polo under their outerwear. They may wear a T-shirt under the polo but it must be white, black or gray. The T-shirt may NOT hang out under the polo. Approved outer wear includes the 1/4 zips sold in the spirit shop with the Bishop Ward logo on the front left pocket and approved Bishop Ward athletic/activity 1/4 zip outerwear. Students may also wear the gray crewneck Bishop Ward sweatshirt as outerwear.


Parents / Guardians can pick up the meals **without kids** being present with them.

ATHLETIC PHYSICALS FOR 2021-2022

Students participating in athletic activities **MUST have a COMPLETED Physical Form on file at school. Physical Forms must be completed by the physician.** Forms may be obtained from the front office, from the Health Office, from the Ward website, or from the head coach. Physical forms for the 2021-2022 school year must be completed by the physician after May 1, 2021. This is a rule from the Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA).

Students will NOT be allowed to try-out or participate in the activity until the school/head coach has received the completed AND signed physical packet. Completed Physical Forms need to be returned to the HEAD COACH OR MS. GREGORY IN THE HEALTH OFFICE. Only Physical Forms issued by the Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA) will be accepted.




