## Benefits of using FACEP for a cultural exchange

- We are a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit incorporation
- Partnered with the La Ligue de L'Énseignement, in the French Ministry of Education
- Safe, structured way to introduce students to where the global community comes together
- Promotes excellence for schools
- Schools have a certain amount of autonomy within the structure of the program
- Real life application of classroom instruction through the use of language and culture
- Immersion in the culture, secure within the program, i.e., not tourists, because daily excursions are planned, and overseen, by the hosting school teachers and parents
- Depending on location of exchange city, day trips to larger cities, e.g. Paris or Marseilles, are possible
- We are the most affordable cultural immersion exchange program available
- Included in the program cost:
  - Airfare
  - Ground travel
  - Health/medical insurance
  - Travel insurance
  - Room and board
  - Instructional materials
  - Activities and excursions

### Benefits to the participating school

#### WE:

- Assume all legal liability
- Provide health/medical and travel insurance for the American and French students, secured through La Ligue de L'Énseignement, during all travel
- Are compliant with the international law EU-US Privacy Shield (replacing, as of 2 Feb 2016,
   International Safe Harbour Privacy Principals set forth by the EU and Swiss governing bodies,
   and that certified the USA as compliant)
- Confirm all parental consents through personal contracts with the individuals participating
- Process, and are responsible for, all financial transactions through our not-for-profit incorporation status
- Secure a French school of corresponding size and make-up
- Have a working relationship with Air France to secure the best possible price, and convenient logistics, to help keep the program as affordable as possible
- Have established policies and resources for unusual and emergency situations

#### What is needed from the hosting school?

- A space for the French students to meet with their traveling teacher(s) while they are here in the USA. This could be a classroom, conference room, cafeteria, auditorium, etc.
- Allow the American teacher to hold student meetings/parent meetings in his/her classroom or another space within the school in preparation for hosting the French and possible travel to France
- Allow the American teacher to make copies if needed for the respective meetings.
- Allow the American teacher to possibly attend one educational excursion while the French are here in the USA.
- Possibly help with providing bus transportation.
- Possibly provide a few lunches for the French Teachers in the cafeteria while they are at the American school.

Overall the cost to the hosting school district is very minimal.
