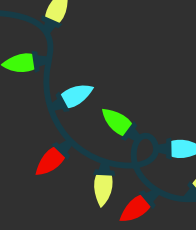

We hope to demonstrate our appreciation and gratitude for many recent events and developments at our school:

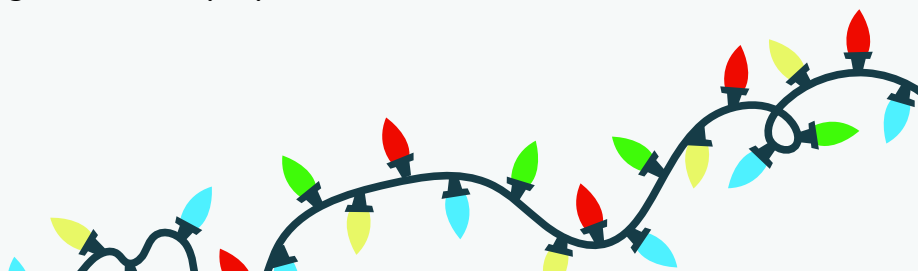

- * Students took their initial i-Ready diagnostic assessment and initial STAR Reading or Star Early Lit Reading assessments in September. During mid-to-late January, students will reassessed in Math and Reading. We will continue to be committed to improving student attendance, student behavior, and student learning by the Winter Benchmarks. Please expect updates on these data points in our February or March Newsletter.

Great success is on our horizon at Barnes Elementary. We have many exciting field trips and experiences (Reptile Man December 20th, Missoula Theater February 13-February 18, specific grade level field trips) to share with our students! The **Family and Community Resource Center (FCRC)** is open and ready to support you!

The FRC was founded in the fall of 2021 with a primary purpose of providing a variety of Health and Human Services that focus on resiliency and self-empowerment to support youth and families be healthy, connected and contributing members of our community.

The **FCRC** is made up of three programs that come together to provide "whole youth and whole family" support.

1. Behavioral Health
2. Physical Health and
3. Basic Needs.

While a main goal of the **FCRC** is to assist families experiencing instability, we help connect *all families* with resources and supports that they may need.

The **FCRC** staff provide an array of services and activities that are integrated, comprehensive, and responsive to the identified needs of youth, families, schools and the community. All services are free of charge.

Our staff fields requests for a variety of resources to help youth and families in need. Those requests typically include items such as; food, school supplies, clothes and personal items. Our team also supports youth families in obtaining state medical insurance, support in making mental and physical health appointments, assistance with employment and navigating housing options in our community.

PLAN FOR INCLEMENT WEATHER

2022-2023 Kelso School District

Snow, ice, and wind can impact our ability to conduct school activities as planned. Depending on the road conditions, any one of the following may happen:

- 1) **Buses are on snow routes.**
All schools and activities continue, but some routes are altered. Snow route details are on our Transportation web page.
- 2) **School is delayed two hours.**
Buses pick up students two hours later than normal; no breakfast or AM preschool.
- 3) **School is canceled for the day.**
All schools, activities, and athletics are canceled for the day.
- 4) **School is dismissed early.**
All activities and athletics are canceled.

HOW WE DECIDE

Before deciding to close schools, district officials consult county road crews and our own employees who are out driving the roads in the early hours of the morning.

Our district covers a large region with steep terrain in places. While roads may be passable in town, conditions may be different just a few miles away. Before we close schools we seek answers to the questions below:

- Can we ensure that buses can navigate streets safely?
- Will students be safe waiting for buses, driving, or walking to school?
- What are the predicted weather conditions later in the school day so we can also ensure students a safe return home?
- Will conditions be substantially improved if we start school late?
- Will we have heat and lights in our schools?

HOW WE INFORM YOU

We attempt to provide you with as much prior notice of school closures as possible. We make every effort to announce changes by 6 AM and we use a variety of methods to get the information to parents and staff.

Portland TV stations will carry basic information about school closures. For more detailed information, especially about changes in bus routes, please listen to local radio stations.

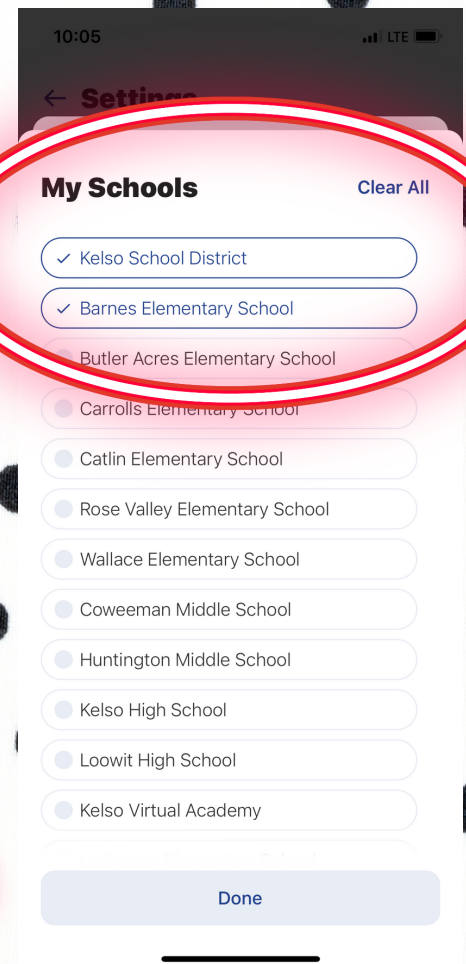
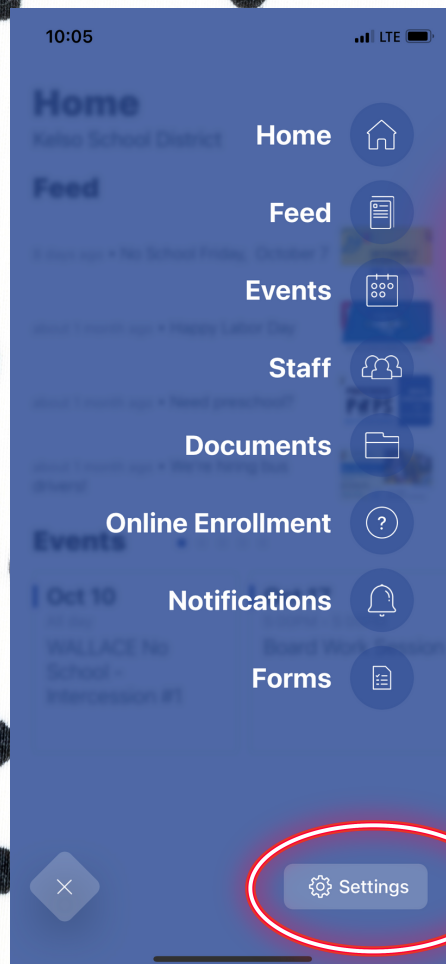

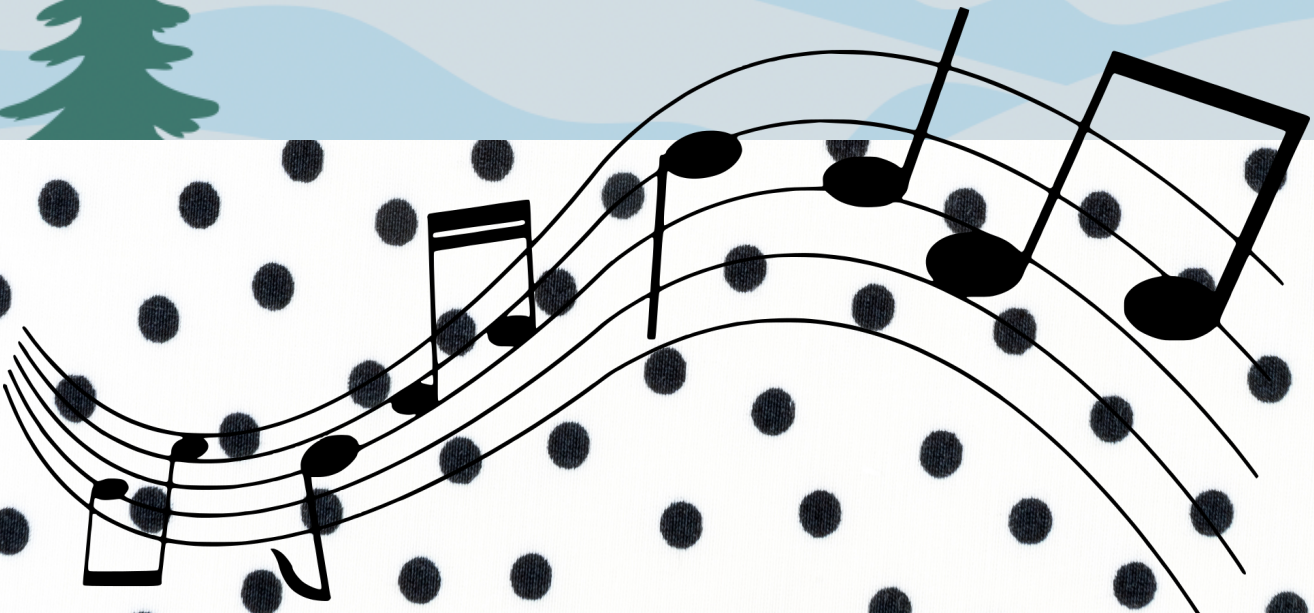

ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

This year, Barnes Elementary is making a special effort to ensure that all students fully benefit from their education by attending school regularly. Student attendance is an essential first step for students to learn. We want you to know that our school is committed to supporting your student(s) to attend and access their education. Your students' future is our first priority, and we want to partner with you to ensure their success.

DID YOU KNOW?

- By being present at school, your child learns valuable social skills and has the opportunity to develop meaningful relationships with other students and school staff.
- Absences can be a sign that a student is losing interest in school, struggling with schoolwork, dealing with a bully, or facing some other potentially serious difficulty.
- Starting in kindergarten, too many absences (excused and unexcused) can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing 10 percent (just two days a month or about 18 days in a year) increases the chance that your student will not read or master math at the same level as their peers.
- Students can still fall behind if they miss just a day or two days every few weeks.
- By 6th grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school.
- By 9th grade, regular and high attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores.

WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU

We miss your student(s) when they are not in school and we value their contributions to our community. We would like you to help ensure that your student attends regularly and is successful in school. If your student is going to be absent, please contact the office at 360-501-1500. You can also enter absences on Skyward Family Access. See page 13 of the newsletter.

What you can expect from Barnes Elementary and Kelso SD for attendance support:

Student accrues 5 unexcused absences
School team meeting with student, parent, counselors (other staff as needed)
Attendance agreement
Risk/needs assessment/questionnaire
School based solutions
Student accrues 7 unexcused absences
Attendance and Re-engagement Program (ARP) workshop referral with Educational Service District (ESD) (virtual, every other Wed @ 4pm) for both student and parent
Review why attendance matters, how to excuse an absence and what for (school rep), Becca Bill & truancy process (probation officer). Statistics on attendance importance will be presented.
Break out rooms with ARP case manager & school rep
Review original Risk/needs assessment/barriers questionnaire to address concerns and acknowledge progress.
Review current skyward account for accuracy
Either direct referral to board or give students one week to re-engage in school. Students will be referred to community resources and progress checked within a week.
Student accrues 10 unexcused absences
Board referral (process of creating an action plan)
Representatives from community resources
Mental health, school rep, ARP case manager, alternative education, Family Community Resource Center, Ethnic support council, etc. (tailored for student needs)
Release of Information (ROI) signed at this level
Complete board agreement form, address barriers, refer to services/set up intakes
Introduce ARP case manager, follow up on services referred, board agreement, attendance expectations
Student does NOT follow board agreement or attendance does NOT improve
Exited from ARP services (ESD Advocate will send Truancy Liaison a report to add to the petition).
Court petition – Kelso School District representative completes and attends court and continues to monitor student attendance

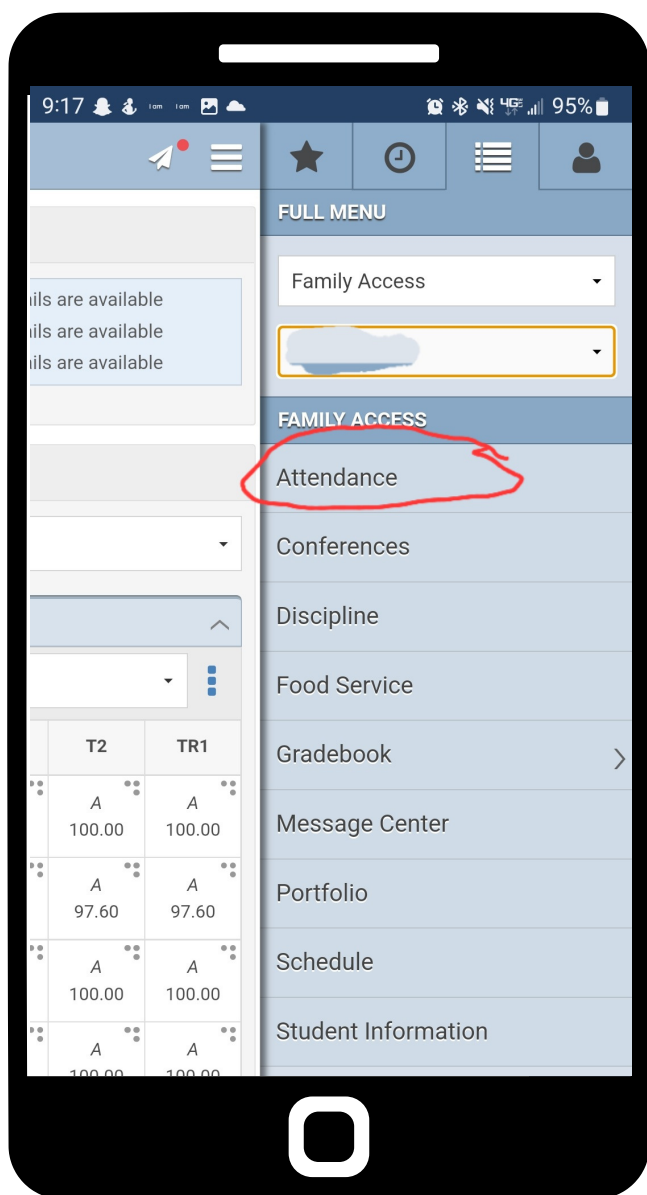
