A LETTER FROM OUR PRINCIPALS!

Barnes Bear families,

I can't believe that half of our 2022-2023 school year has already passed. During my first six months of service, we have had many positive developments to celebrate:

- Building stronger connections with our community
 1. Back to School Night, Reptile Man and the Thankful Family Event.
- Creating stronger connections with our students
 1. Field trips- BiZi Farms (K-1), Oregon Children's Theatre (K-5), Triangle Bowl & Vernie's Pizza (3rd & 4th), Rollerdom (5th)
 2. At school experiences- "Cocoa & Create", "Once Upon a Painting" ...
- Re-booting, recommitting, and reinventing foundational practices and systems
 1. Academically, we are in the first year of our new math curriculum adoption with i-Ready.
 2. Every Wednesday, our staff dresses up in College OR Career attire, as a potential ice breaker to teach our kids about potential future opportunities.
 3. With Social Emotional Learning, we are recommitting ourselves to the 4 B's practices that made us successful for so many years!

Despite these successes, I believe our grade level and schoolwide systems can improve. We are relentlessly working, and will continue to do so, in our pursuit to become more intentional in our collective practices.

Project Aristotle, a Google Study on the traits of highly effective teams, leads my thinking as an elementary school principal. The study concluded that the most successful teams have these five characteristics:

- 1) Psychological safety- team members feel safe to take risks and be vulnerable in front of each other.
- 2) Dependability- team members get things done on time and meet the organization's high bar for excellence.
- 3) Structure & Clarity- team members have clear roles, plans, and goals.
- 4) Meaning- work is personally important to team members.
- 5) Impact- team members think their work matters and that it creates change.

It is my hope your child (or children) will benefit from our intentional hard work, commitment, and expertise. Over the next three years, we want to improve Parent Involvement that ultimately increases student learning. We want to incorporate strategies that will engage all of our families, particularly families who have NOT participated with their child's schooling. I hope to also focus on improving our poor student attendance rates.

So, if you see me outside of the school or you volunteer for a field trip, please introduce yourself. I am slowly getting to know more and more of our Barnes community. Thank you for the opportunity to serve.

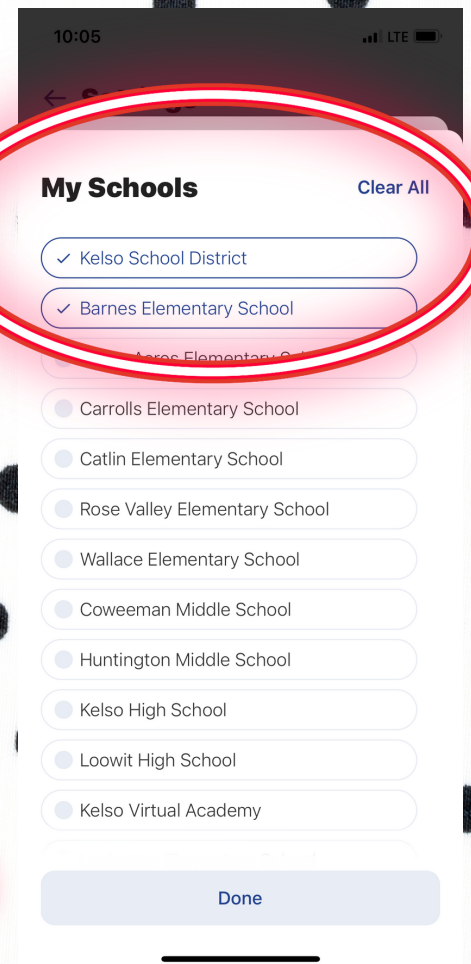
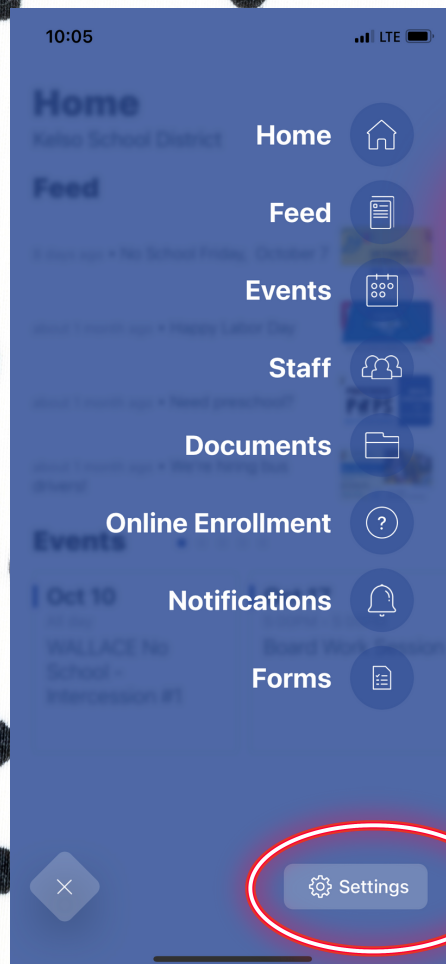

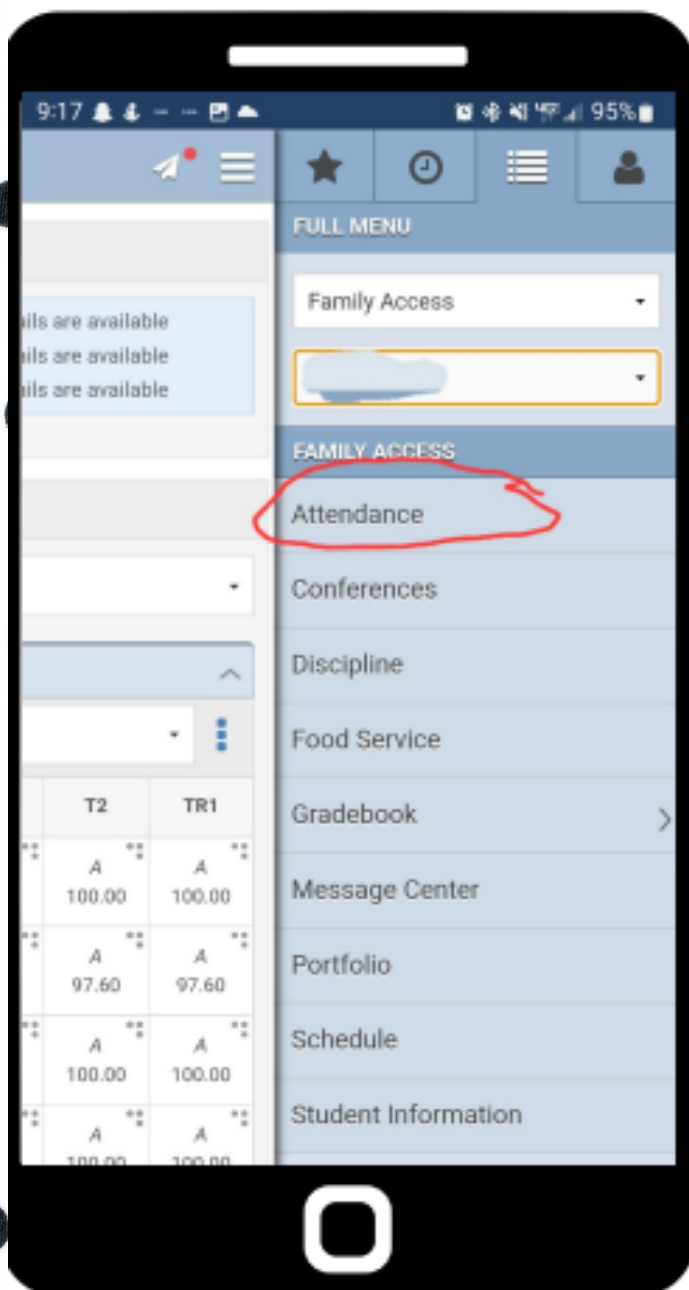

PLAN FOR INCLEMENT WEATHER

2022-2023 Kelso School District

Snow, ice, and wind can impact our ability to conduct school activities as planned. Depending on the road conditions, any one of the following may happen:

- 1) **Buses are on snow routes.**
All schools and activities continue, but some routes are altered. Snow route details are on our Transportation web page.
- 2) **School is delayed two hours.**
Buses pick up students two hours later than normal; no breakfast or AM preschool.
- 3) **School is canceled for the day.**
All schools, activities, and athletics are canceled for the day.
- 4) **School is dismissed early.**
All activities and athletics are canceled.

HOW WE DECIDE

Before deciding to close schools, district officials consult county road crews and our own employees who are out driving the roads in the early hours of the morning.

Our district covers a large region with steep terrain in places. While roads may be passable in town, conditions may be different just a few miles away. Before we close schools we seek answers to the questions below:

- Can we ensure that buses can navigate streets safely?
- Will students be safe waiting for buses, driving, or walking to school?
- What are the predicted weather conditions later in the school day so we can also ensure students a safe return home?
- Will conditions be substantially improved if we start school late?
- Will we have heat and lights in our schools?

HOW WE INFORM YOU

We attempt to provide you with as much prior notice of school closures as possible. We make every effort to announce changes by 6 AM and we use a variety of methods to get the information to parents and staff.

KSD App

Download the Kelso School District app and enable notifications for the district and/or specific schools.

We'll use the cell phone number and email you have listed in Skyward. Please make sure your contact information is correct.

Flash Alert

Subscribe to FlashAlert to receive weather-related schedule changes by email and/or text. Push notification is available with the FlashAlert app. To subscribe, look under the "How do I" tab on our website: kelso.wednet.edu.

Radio/Television

Portland TV stations will carry basic information about school closures. For more detailed information, especially about changes in bus routes, please listen to local radio stations.

DEFINITE THREAT OF VIOLENCE OR HARM

- **CLOSE/LOCK** external entrances
- **CLOSE/LOCK** classroom doors - stay out of sight

- **MONITOR** communications



SECURE & TEACH

POTENTIAL THREAT OF HARM

- **CLOSE/LOCK** classroom doors

SHELTER IN PLACE

HAZARDOUS OUTDOOR ATMOSPHERE

- **SHELTER** in a safe area
- **ISOLATE** your environment
- **SHUT OFF** HVAC / air systems
- **HEAD COUNT** & collect students
- **MONITOR** communications
- **PREPARE** to evacuate
- **WAIT** for "all clear"



EVACUATE

FIRE / INTERNAL THREAT

- **EXIT** building to nearest rally point
- If **RALLY POINT** is unsafe, go to a safe area
- **HEAD COUNT** & collect students
- **PREPARE** to reunify

KEY REMINDERS

- **NO PROPPED OPEN DOORS**
- **MAINTAIN ADULT VISIBILITY**
- **SEE or HEAR SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING**
