A LETTER FROM OUR TESTING COORDINATORS

Dear Barnes Elementary 3-5 Families:

It's that time of year again, when students in grades 3-5 will take the Smarter Balanced Assessments in English language arts, mathematics and science.

The 2023 Grades 3-5 ELA and math exams are administered over four sessions. In addition, students in grade 5 will take the Washington Comprehensive Assessment of Science (WCAS). Students are asked to demonstrate their knowledge and skills in the areas of reading, writing, math and science.

- Tuesday, May 2 - ELA Day 1 (5th grade)**
- Thursday May 4 - ELA Day 2 (5th grade)**
- Tuesday, May 9 - ELA day 1 (3rd & 4th grades) AND Math Day 1 (5th grade)**
- Thursday, May 11 - ELA day 2 (3rd & 4th grades) AND Math Day 2 (5th grade)**
- Tuesday, May 16 - Math Day 1 (3rd & 4th grades)**
- Thursday, May 18 - Math Day 2 (3rd & 4th grades) AND Science Day 1 (Grade 5 only)**

It is important for students to be present for all sessions of the test. Should a student be absent for a portion of the exam, the test will be administered to the student when they return. A good night's sleep prior to testing and breakfast each morning will help your child to be well-rested and energized for the assessments. Our students are well prepared and we are confident that they will perform to the best of their ability.

If you have any questions about the Smarter Balanced testing, please contact us, or your child's teacher at 360-501-1500. The exam results are typically released in the fall.

HAPPENING NOW!

Registration for the Kindergarten students for the 2023-2024 school year has begun. Pick up registration packets in the school office or online at <https://www.kelso.wednet.edu/page/online-enrollment>

Students need to be five years of age before midnight August 31, 2023 to be eligible to enter school in the fall.
