### The Community

Spanning 543 square miles and 161,000 residents, Martin County School District is one of the nation's fastest growing suburban areas. Currently the district consists of three comprehensive high schools. Jensen Beach High School serves the northern part of the county: Jensen Beach, Sewall's Point, and northern Stuart.

### The School

Jensen Beach High School is a comprehensive four-year high school with a current enrollment of 1436 students. The school opened in August 2004 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 2006. The demographics are 70% Caucasian, 17% Hispanic, 7% African American and 6% varying races and ethnicities.

### COVID-19 Affect on our School

In March 2020, our district switched to virtual instruction for the remainder of the school year. Students were offered the opportunity to secure a laptop from the district and given WIFI hotspots as necessary. Our grading system did not change.

### The Curriculum

The academic program is currently organized on a seven 50 minute period schedule. In previous years, students took two 100-minute classes and three 50-minute classes daily. Seven credits per year is the maximum course load with credits being earned by semester.

### Academic Highlights

Academic courses are offered at a level of rigor appropriate for preparing students for whatever level of post-secondary education best fits their needs, abilities and career goals. Our levels of rigor range from Honors in all core subjects, Dual Enrollment opportunities at Indian River State College (with three courses being offered on the high school campus) and 25 Advanced Placement courses. We are the only high school in the county to offer the AP Capstone Diploma and we offer AP courses both in core and elective subject areas. All sciences are laboratory sciences. World Language includes Spanish and American Sign Language. All Jensen Beach High School students are encouraged to complete a career technical program of study to allow every student to leave high school with salable skills that can provide further post-secondary education or employment opportunities. Career technical programs include Entrepreneurship, Early Childhood, Global Finance, Drafting, Engineering, Health Science, Digital Design, and TV Production. Several of our programs are articulated with Indian River State College and the Florida University System which can serve to begin college credit accumulation. Our commitment to rigor extends to our elective programs such as Air Force JROTC and our award winning fine arts programs of Art, Band, Drama, and Jubilate, which is our choral program.

### Extracurricular Highlights

With over 30 extracurricular clubs/organizations to choose from, Jensen Beach High offers many opportunities for students to become involved. All of our organizations require service projects to be completed throughout the course of the school year. Our athletic program with over 17 teams is consistently honored to have state champions, recognition for highest overall GPAs, and students earning scholarships to play at the collegiate level including Division I schools.
