Instruction will be provided in-person when it is safe to do so. If the school district closes attendance centers due to COVID, instruction will resume online immediately. All courses and extra-curricular activities will be provided online for all students to the greatest extent possible. If students do not have access to online materials from home, paper packets will be provided to be picked up by parents/students or delivered to students in their residence. Students will have access to the school counselor while in-person but also virtually during remote learning. Staff will communicate with students regularly if attendance centers are closed and monitor for academic, social, and emotional problems that may surface.

Rock County Public School staff will be provided with planning time in accordance with the negotiated agreement. Rock County School Board of Education will also consider recommendations by administration when appropriate, for altering the calendar in order to give staff breaks or needed work time.
