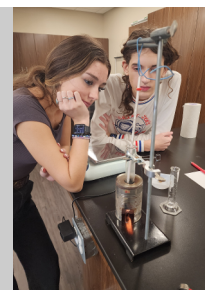
## Marketing

## Advanced Placement Courses

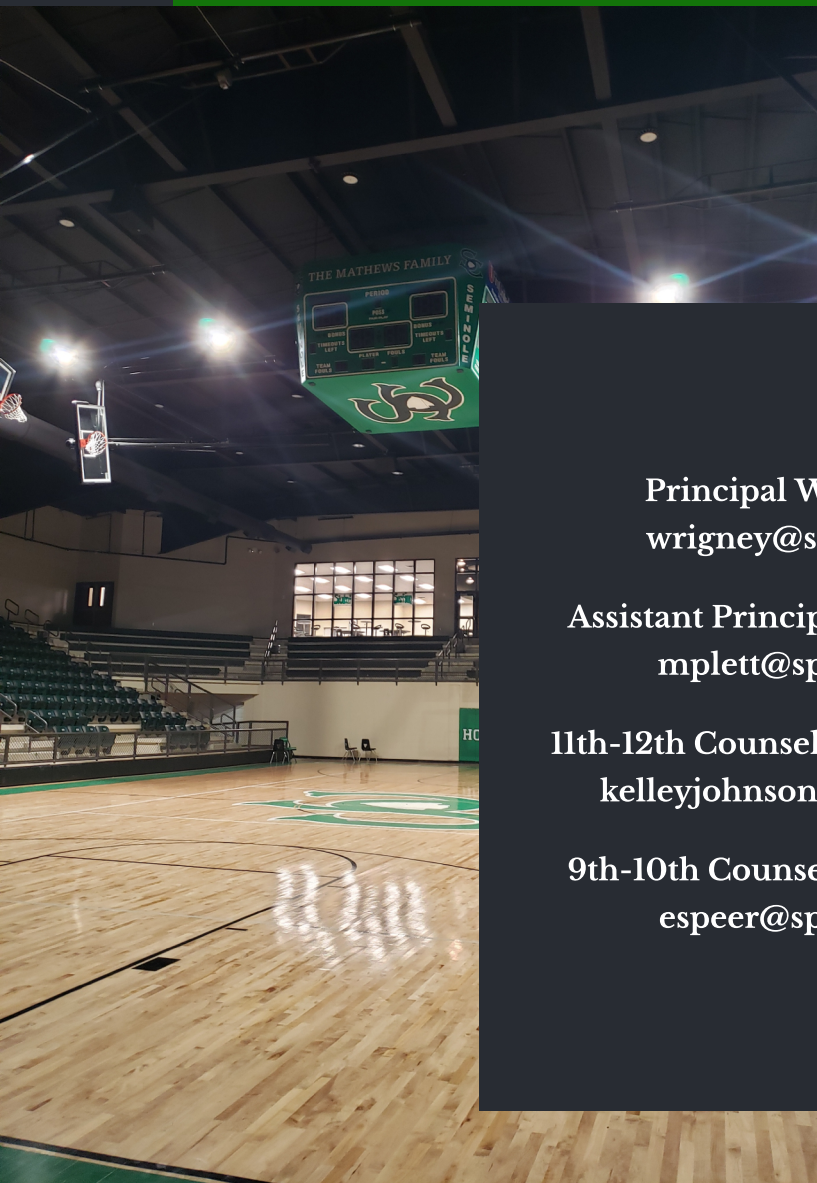
