Aviation Courses



The Seminole High Aviation Program provides students with a project-based learning environment focused on engineering through aeronautics, aerospace, and aviation. The program provides a diverse STEM curriculum that offers students multiple pathways to future careers. The program utilizes the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association's aviation curriculum.

Culinary Arts

Working as a chef, cook or food preparation worker involves the ability to work as an efficient team member. Marketing
