

Off Campus Lunch

2022-2023

Students in grades 4 through 12 are allowed to leave campus for lunch. In order to make open campus safe for all students, students *may walk or be picked up by a parent or guardian only*. Students driving to campus, may not drive to lunch regardless of location of parked vehicle (on or off campus)

The lunch period is 35 minutes. Students are responsible for returning to class on time.

Violations

Students are expected to follow the Student Code of Conduct while off campus. Disciplinary action will be taken on students not returning on time, driving during lunch hours, or misbehavior off campus.

- 1st Offense On campus lunch for 1 week
- 2nd Offense On campus lunch for the remainder of the semester
- 3rd Offense On campus lunch for the remainder of the school year

Additional disciplinary action may be taken for Student Code of Conduct violations.
