Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) Training for Classified Staff Members

Dear HESD Classified Staff Members,

HESD is inviting eight (8) classified staff members to participate in a Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) training from August 2-6, 8:00-4:00 daily. The RBT training will be facilitated by the Ventura County SELPA and will be 8-hours per day for a total of 40 hours. It will also include a required test (in addition to the 40-hour course) to be taken by each participant after the training is completed in order to receive your RBT certification.

The training will be free of charge to selected participants.

Participants will be paid their hourly rate to attend the RBT training and to take the final assessment. Completion of the entire 40-hour training and a passing score on the final assessment will be required in order to receive compensation.

Individuals who are selected to participate and complete the training will be placed in a pool of district-wide RBTs who will be assigned, by seniority, to students in need of RBT services. When not servicing students, RBTs will be assigned to other classified positions that they are qualified for.
