Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012 of Education Law, in order to be granted tenure the teacher must receive composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-c and/or 3012d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in a least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period, you shall not be eligible for tenure at that time. Salary for the 2021-22 school year shall be at Step C, as set forth in the collective bargaining agreement with the Westfield Teachers' Association.

Salary for the 2021-22 school year shall be at Step F, as set forth in the collective bargaining agreement with the Westfield Teachers' Association.

Moved by and seconded by that, upon 3. the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Westfield Academy and Central School District Board of Education hereby appoints Keely Geise, who will hold an Initial Certificate in English Language Arts 7-12, pending NYS Education Dept. approval, in the English tenure area for a probationary period commencing on July 1, 2021 and ending on June 30, 2025. This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012 of Education Law, in order to be granted tenure the teacher must receive composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-c and/or 3012d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in a leastthree (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period, you shall not be eligible for tenure at that

time. Salary for the 2021-22 school year shall be at Step A, as set forth in the collective bargaining agreement with the Westfield Teachers' Association.
