2023-2024 SMART DEVICE POLICY

The definition of a smart device is any device that has the ability to access data and actively communicate information such as but not limited to texts, messages, calls, or pictures. Once students arrive on campus, all smart devices MUST be kept in lockers and/or vehicles and turned off. Smart watches cannot be worn during instructional time for any reason and are encouraged to be left at home. If a device goes off during school hours by ringing, vibrating, or is visible in any manner, the device will be confiscated and will be returned to the parent/guardian and the student will receive an administrative disciplinary consequence such as but not limited to out of school suspension, Saturday school, or detention. Phones, smart watches, or any other device may be confiscated up to five days. All confiscated devices can and will be reviewed by administration. If confiscated devices show another student using a device during school hours, they will also be subjected to the same disciplinary action. Repeat violators of this policy may be recommended for expulsion from Houma Christian School.
