

GRADUATION CEREMONY

The Board believes that the graduation ceremony is a celebration of those students that have completed the state and local requirements for graduation. So being, it is the policy of the Board to allow only students that have completed their graduation requirements to participate in the ceremony. Students that are short credits and did not meet the graduation requirements will not be eligible to participate in the ceremony. Students that graduate early will not be permitted to walk in the graduation ceremony.

Students that are short credits may still finish up their delinquent credits in the summer and receive their signed diploma upon completion of those credits.

At the completion of the fourth quarter, the Superintendent will select a Valedictorian and Salutatorian for each graduating class based solely on GPA. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian will get to speak at the graduation ceremony.

In the case of a tie for Valedictorian, both students will be named Valedictorian and no Salutatorian will be named. Both Valedictorians will be allowed to speak at the ceremony. In the case of a tie for Salutatorian, both students will be named and recognized. The Valedictorian and both Salutatorians will be allowed to speak at the ceremony.
