Approval of minutes from last meeting – Will be approved during the next meeting due to corrections.

Treasurer's Report – Not available. Missing deposits and reimbursements

Principal's Report/Dates – Not available. Mr. Ricenbaw was absent.

OLD BUSINESS:

- A. Veteran's Day – it was another successful event.
- B. Reimbursement for gate – Still waiting for this info. Mr. Ricenbaw absent, tabled for now.
- C. Food for parent/teacher conferences – 37 bottles of pop were used from PTO for this event.
- D. Youth Frontiers – Popcorn was made. 200 small bags with 1 scoop of popcorn each. The small bags were inexpensive and worked better than the coffee filters. For future reference, the popcorn was started at 12:30 and was ready by 2:30. 8 oz bags of unpopped corn were 99¢/package (22 packages were used = \$21.78 total cost); Bags were less than 1¢/each (\$2.00 total). Total cost for everything was \$23.78.
- E. Basketball Concessions – Still struggling to get volunteers.
- F. PTO Dances – Christmas theme. We need more chaperone volunteers
- G. Teacher Wish Lists/Chromebooks – Tabled for now since Mr. Ricenbaw was absent.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Science Fair – Tuesday, December 19th – A menu was decided on for the judges. We will need dessert donations.
- B. New Policy – Mr. Schere asked us to come up with ideas on how to handle students who wish to leave the dance prior to the ending of the dance. There may be a liability issue for parents believing their children are at the dance they were dropped off at if we let the students leave the dance of their own free will before the dance is over. PTO recommended that students who leave prior to 8:45 pm must be signed out by their parents at the check in table. Students may also be signed out by another parent if the office is notified before the close of business the day of the dance.
- C. Miscellaneous – How old is the popcorn machine? Mary will check to see date of purchased. What is the possibility of investing in a new popcorn machine? We should test to see if the repaired switch still works and/or if it falls in so that we don't have to completely unplug the machine between popping to avoid intense smoking. Coke Machine has been replaced and is working correctly now. Hamlow/WIS PTO will be using our popcorn popper for the Mother/Son dance. They will reimburse WMS PTO for popcorn used.
