

Exiting COVID Reopening Plan to begin at the end of school on May 19th

A. Controlling what we can control

- i. HVAC plasma scrubbers, to be paid for through ESSER money, cleans 99% of indoor air
- ii. Disinfection-continue with the disinfection scheduling we've been following-this helps with allergies, flu and all viruses-keeping staff and students in face to face school

B. Returning to normalcy

- i. Choice of wearing masks or not
- ii. Open facilities to patrons and outside groups
- iii. Weight room cards-all shut off and we start "fresh/new" on June 1st-they must "reapply"
 - a. For those who've paid-this year's \$30 paid fee would be honored for this coming year's fee
- iii. Facilities not open to "students only", all activities MUST have adult supervision
- iv. Handwashing routines will continue to be taught

C. Continue working with the Wabaunsee County Health Department-utilizing them as the "health experts".

- i. Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine
- ii. Diagnostic and screening testing
- iii. Vaccinations
- iv. Appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to health and safety policies

Continuity of services:

A. Academic needs

- a. Virtual learning has been offered by Greenbush Service Center

B. Social Emotional Mental Health

- a. Hired an additional PK-8 counselor (ESSER funds)
- b. Continuing grants
 - i. KSDE MHIT-school mental health liaison
 - 1. MOU with CrossWinds Services supplying a case manager, 2 FT therapist
 - ii. SRO

C. Food Service

- a. Provided free meals per KSDE guidelines in June
- b. Continue providing free meals during school year per KSDE guidelines
