# Foundation Scholarship Application Process

### Who is Eligible

\*\*\*Any person who is the natural, adopted child or stepchild of a "qualified" Nucor employee.\*\*\*

### A "qualified" employee is one who meets these requirements:

- Has been a full-time, active employee of Nucor for at least six months prior to the date the scholarship is applied for.
- Continues to be employed from the date the scholarship is applied for until the date it is awarded
- Is not an Executive Officer, Director of Nucor or an Officer or Director of Nucor Foundation at the date of application for the scholarship or date it is awarded.
- Must not be a "disqualified person" with respect to the Foundation as the term is defined the Internal Revenue Code section 4946(a) (i.e., certain person affiliated with the Foundation or with substantial contributions to the Foundation).
