Applicants must be in their senior year of high school and maintain at least a 2.5 GPA during the final two semesters of school.

This scholarship award will be made without regard to race, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, political affiliation, social or economic status.

This scholarship award is not renewable.

Scholarship deadline for submission is April 28, 2023.

One application per student.

- Your essay of about 500 words, typed and double spaced and in 12-point font.
- A Statement of Eligibility complete with your signature and the signature of your school guidance counselor attached to your essay.

Write an essay about a time that you or someone you know has been in a situation where you were tempted to experiment with drugs and/or alcohol. Explain how the situation was dealt with and what you learned from it. How do you think that you could help others if they were faced with a similar situation?

STATEMENT OF ELIGIBILITY
