<u>Attendance Policy:</u> Good attendance is vital to student success. Studies show that students who are frequently absent have lower grades, lower self-esteem, and increased behavior problems. We want to help all of our students to be successful and have set up guidelines for attendance.

Students are expected to be in school every day possible, but we realize that there are some reasons for absences. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to call <u>by 9:30 am on the day of absence</u> when a student is absent letting us know the reason for the absence, or you will receive a call. If no call was received, the student must bring a written note from his parent or guardian stating the reason for the absence. A doctor's note is necessary for illnesses; please turn those notes into the teacher or office after an absence. Automatic calls will begin at 10:30.
