OUT-OF-BOUNDARY REQUESTS FOR 2023-24: Parents who wish to have their child(ren) attend an elementary building other than their neighborhood school must submit an out-of-boundary request. An out-of-boundary request needs to be completed each school year. Requests must be submitted no later than Friday, May 12, 2023. Forms are available in the elementary offices or at the Administration Office. The request must specify the school desired and include parent(s) name, address, telephone contact, student's name and anticipated grade for NEXT year. If an out-of-boundary request is approved, transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Action will be taken on requests in late May and parents will be notified of decisions in early June. Out-of-boundary requests received after the May 12 deadline will be reviewed in late August for consideration.

Reminder: Please watch the weather and dress your child appropriately. **School appropriate clothing must be worn to school.** Any clothing that distracts from learning, or creates an unsafe situation, should not be worn to school. Such items include:

- Shirts with spaghetti straps / crop tops
- Flip flops
- Leggings-must be covered by a long shirt
- High heeled shoes or wedges are unsafe at school
- Short shorts are not to be worn
