Accommodations for children with disabilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Students with an IEP, 504 Plan, and other documented student supports will have all supports and accommodations made available to them.</li></ul>
Coordination with state and local officials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● We will follow all state and local health guidance.</li></ul>
Continuity of Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Academic Needs will be met through the instruction of our staff following the Kansas Curricular Standards.</li><li>● Social, Emotional, and mental health needs will be met through SEC curriculum and counselors.</li><li>● Other needs, include student health and food service-all students will have access to breakfast and lunch daily as well as school nursing services.</li></ul>
