End of Year Schedule for Seniors

- -All senior academic assignments are due by Wednesday, June 2 (there is not a separate grading category for final exams/assignments this year, so any final work will be incorporated into the 4th marking period. For full year courses, each of the 4 marking periods this year will comprise 25% of the final grade).
- *Any seniors who still have work to complete/make-up after the June 2nd deadline will have until June 17th to do so. Please communicate directly with teachers if you still owe any assignments.
- -Promenade and Prom are on Thursday, June 3rd. Seniors will not attend classes on June 3rd, but there will be an in-person assembly for all seniors on the morning of June 3rd starting at 8:30 AM. At this assembly we will review promenade/prom procedures, discuss Graduation and Project Graduation, and collect Chromebooks/chargers and textbooks/other school materials.
- -Seniors/prom attendees are excused from classes on Friday, June 4th.
- -The week of June 7th is the senior trip. Those seniors not attending the trip will not be required to attend classes, provided their grades and attendance are in order.
- -There will be another opportunity to return any school materials that you owe on Friday, June 11 from 1:15 2:30 PM in the cafeteria (for those of you not going on senior trip).
- -The final week of school the week of June 14th seniors will not attend classes.
- -On Wednesday, June 16th at 10:00 AM, we will be having a yearbook distribution and signing event for seniors (all seniors will receive a yearbook this year). We will also distribute graduation caps/gowns.
- -Graduation practice will be in the morning at school on Wednesday, June 23 and Thursday, June 24 at 11:00 AM . Two tickets for seated graduation guests and Project Graduation t-shirts will be distributed at practice.
- -Graduation is Thursday, June 24th at 6:30 PM (with a rain date of Friday, June 25). Project Graduation will be immediately following graduation at the Big Event in Cherry Hill.

GRADUATION INFORMATION

Graduation Practices: Wednesday, June 23rd and Thursday 24th at 11:00 AM (meet in cafeteria)

It is important that seniors be on time for graduation practices. Your total cooperation will be required. Graduates are expected to conduct themselves in a mature fashion during rehearsal. Students who fail to cooperate during rehearsal will be removed from the graduation service. Failure to attend a rehearsal and/or unexcused lateness may result in the student not being able to participate in graduation. You must rehearse in order to march.

Graduation: Thursday, June 24th at 6:30 PM (Rain Date: Friday, June 25th at 6:30 PM) on the CHS football field.

- -Due to limited available seating, on the field we will be able to provide seats for the graduates, faculty and staff, and two (2) guests per graduate. At graduation practice, each senior will receive two (2) tickets for their seated guests. These tickets will need to be presented at graduation by guests who will be sitting on the football field.
- -Graduates, however, can bring additional guests to the ceremony. Those additional guests do not need tickets and will be able to view the ceremony from the bleachers or in standing room only sections behind the fence to the field. Guests in these sections may also, if they wish, bring their own chairs for viewing the ceremony.
- -Graduates should arrive at 5:45 PM on the day of graduation so that we can line everyone up for the procession.
- -We ask that graduation attendees park their cars in Knight Park or at available side street parking on the streets near campus. The parking spaces behind school will be reserved for those who need handicapped parking. If you have a guest who needs handicapped parking, please email Mr. McKinney at tmckinney@collsk12.org

Required attire for Graduation

- 1. No dangling earrings, necklaces or corsages.
- 2. White <u>flat</u> shoes (in order to make walking on the field easier) or dark dress shoes (no sneakers)
- 3. Attire for underneath gown: Light colored dress, pants or skirt and blouse or white collared dress shirt with necktie and dark colored dress slacks
- 4. Pin or scotch tape tassel to cap over corner of right eye.
- 5. Wear hat straight long end in back.
- 6. No eating or chewing gum.
- 7. Carry in left hand in gown sleeve.
- 8. We strongly recommend that you do not bring a pocketbook and/or other valuables to the service.

Additional Notes for Seniors

- -Seniors need to complete their mandatory graduation survey that was sent by the counselors, if they have not done so already this helps us track post secondary information for the school profile.
- -Seniors who received scholarships please send your thank you notes.
- -School email once the Genesis rollover happens in the summer, students will lose access to their school email account. Students should save or forward any information from their school email to their personal email as soon as possible.
