

Lincoln Parish Schools Ready to Achieve 2022-23

Our schools and district leaders have been working on detailed plans for reopening schools and providing educational services this fall using the Louisiana Department of Education's Guidelines updated on August 12, 2022. The Lincoln Parish School Board will work diligently to help our students and employees remain safe throughout this pandemic. Together, we are *Ready to Achieve* in Lincoln Parish. *Revised August 2022*

Monitoring of COVID Symptoms	 Students and employees should isolate at home for 5 days upon testing positive for COVID-19 ✓ Day 1 is the actual test date or the first full day after your symptoms started ✓ Symptoms must have improved and no fever for 24 hours before returning on day 6 ✓ Masks must be worn on days 6-10 ✓ Untested symptomatic students and employees (when other family member(s) in the home is/are positive for COVID-19), should isolate for 5 days and return with a mask on days 6-10 if symptoms have improved and no fever has been present for 24 hours. Day 1 should be the test date of the family member who tested positive
Environment Cleaning and Personal Hygiene	 School facilities have received a thorough cleaning in preparation of the return of teachers and students. High traffic areas and high touch areas in classrooms and facilities will be cleaned at least once during the school day. An isolation area will be designated at each school site for students who are ill. Each school will be assigned a school nurse.
Transportation	 Masks are optional for all students and adults while traveling on a school bus. This includes traveling to and from school and athletic events, etc.
Hygienic Supplies	 School employees will be provided adequate access to hygienic supplies, including soap, hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol, paper towels, and disinfectant spray as needed.
Student Programming Determinations	 Instruction will be in-person unless a student meets criteria for temporary homebound services. For more information on homebound services or to request an application, you may contact Dr. Sheila Nugent at 318-255-1430 ext 245 (Medical documentation is required and must accompany application). Student placement determinations are based on in person instruction or homebound services. Student placement determinations should take into the medical needs of a student, as identified by the parent or guardian and the student's physician.
Visitors to School Facilities	Masks will be optional for visitors to school campuses.
Miscellaneous for Students	 Masks are optional for all students in grades K-12. Students will be responsible for missed work when absent for positivity or being symptomatic. Students should access their teachers' Google Classrooms for information on assignments.
