All firms interested in submitting SOQs in response to this RFQ are required to attend. SOQs submitted by firms who do not attend the Mandatory Pre-Proposal Meeting will be rejected.

Any Statements of Qualifications received after the Submission Deadline will not be considered. Faxed and/or emailed SOQs cannot be accepted and will not be considered. The School Board and its Selection Review Committee reserves the right to reject any or all Statements of Qualifications for just cause, and to waive any informalities when it is in the best interest of the School Board.

The Lincoln Parish School Board strongly encourages the participation of small, minority-owned, and women's business enterprises in all contracts or procurements let by the Board for goods and services. To that end, all contractors and suppliers are encouraged to utilize minority business enterprises in the purchase of sub-contracting of materials, supplies, and services in which minority owned businesses are available.
