REMINDER: All mandatory Vector trainings are due by next Wednesday, August 30th.



In July 2023, the Lincoln Parish School Board approved a One-Time Retention and Recruitment payment for full-time salaried certified, professional, and support staff and part-time/hourly staff who are scheduled to work at least 20 hours per week on a regular schedule.

In order to be eligible, an employee MUST meet all of the following criteria:

- Be a full-time salaried staff member or a part-time/hourly staff member who is scheduled to work at least 20 hours per week on a regular schedule; AND
- Be actively employed and working on September 1, 2023; AND
 Complete 100% of required employee trainings in the Vector sy
- Complete 100% of required employee trainings in the Vector system on or before August 30, 2023 (excluding Compass Evaluator Training); AND
 Sign the Compensation Agreement in Frontline Central by Friday,
- September 8 (details below).

 The stipend payment will be made October 25, 2023.

If you are in a stipend-eligible position and completed 100% of the required

trainings by the deadline, you will be sent a Compensation Agreement in Frontline Central on Friday, September 1.

The agreement must be <u>signed by the employee by Friday, September 8</u> to

receive the stipend. Direct supervisors will also have to sign each agreement. This is required for federal funding documentation.

If you do not receive a Compensation Agreement in Frontline Central by

Tuesday, September 5, and believe that you should have, please contact your supervisor.
