- Administrators, Counselors, COS members, Department Chairs, Teachers - ALL critical to the process

- BHS/FH combined - consistency and single program for all 9-12 students
- BHS/FH POS transitioned to Google format and some content rearranged for better flow

General

- Courses added to gifted service model
 - PLTW
 - AP Music Theory
 - Scholarship/Honors designation Band/Choir ensembles
 - Scholarship Design Thinking 301 and 401
- Schedule change policy added
 - Tightens restrictions on class changes due to staffing/sections needs determined during scheduling process
- GPA explanation added



College Credit Plus

- Overview/District Statement
- Timeline provided - process completion by June 5
 - Constructed to coincide with district scheduling and more aggressive than college requirements
- Scheduling procedures outlined

*No changes to on-campus offerings - 19 courses total

Art



- Course of Study year
- Elimination
 - Arts/Crafts
 - Printmaking
 - AP 2D Art Studio
- Honors Portfolio designation
- Condense course offerings - minimize prerequisites to allow more student access to courses
- Minor changes to some course descriptions



Business

- Course of Study year
- New Course - Introduction to Computer Programming
- Matrix created for courses offered during the next four years
 - Diverse offerings maintained with current staffing level
- Personal Finance - required course beginning with Class of 2024
- Accounting I and II
 - Semester courses - new descriptions
 - Scholarship designation for Accounting II
- Minor course description changes
- Decrease course fees



English

- Course fees added for core English courses
 - Membean has \$5 per student access fee
- No course changes or updates
- Addition of summer reading language to Honors/AP courses



World Language

- Course of Study year
- No course changes
- Language added regarding combining levels based on enrollment
- Year IV/V of language rotate curriculum each year based on content and themes established by the College Board.



Industrial Technology

- Course of Study year
- Engineering Drafting - replaces semester courses of CAD and mechanical drawing (full year course)
- Woodworking II - semester course



Mathematics

- Elimination of Algebra IB (no longer offered)
- New course description for Algebra I
- No other changes



Music - Instrumental

- Course of Study year
- Addition of Scholarship status and Honors option to:
 - Symphonic Band
 - Wind Symphony
 - **Additional course requirements/expectations at upper level courses warrant scholarship designation
 - Further requirements an option to achieve Honors designation



Music - Vocal

- Course of Study year
- Addition of Scholarship and Honors option for Beaver Creek Chorale
 - Further requirements an option to achieve Scholarship/Honors designation
- Addition of Scholarship status and Honors option to Women's Choir
 - Further requirements an option to achieve Honors designation



Music - Department

- Addition of Music Theory I - semester course
- Addition of AP Music Theory II - semester course

No additional staffing

Current music enrollment not a prerequisite, though director consultation and musical experience required



Health/Physical Education

- Course of Study year
- Update PE Waiver to include Show Choir (per ODE guidelines)
- Elimination of Fitness statement
- Elimination of Outdoor Education
- Addition of Weight Training II
- Sports Medicine now ½ credit course grades 9-12
- Minor updates to course descriptions



Music - Department

- Addition of Music Theory I - semester course
- Addition of AP Music Theory II - semester course

No additional staffing

Current music enrollment not a prerequisite, though director consultation and musical experience required

Science



- AP Physics: Mechanics
 - Eliminated AP Physics: Electricity and Magnetism component (time intensive and unable to combine effectively - aspects of electricity and magnetism added as time permits)
- Minor description changes



Social Studies

- Design Thinking Course of Study year
 - Scholarship designation for 301 and 401
- Minor description changes

Engineering Technologies - PLTW



- IED - Freshmen Only
- AEP - Grades 10-11-12
- Scholarship Designation
 - Aerospace Engineering
 - Grades 11-12 only
 - Digital Electronics
 - Grades 11-12 only; CTAG college course credit available
 - Computer Science Principles
 - AP Computer Science exam available
- Honors Designation
 - Engineering Design and Development Capstone
 - Independent Study with industry advisors; application and instructor permission required



Other Electives

- Addition of AFJROTC III (next phase of implementation)
- Elimination of AFJROTC II
 - AFJROTC II and III content will rotate each year until the full four year implementation cycle is completed
 - AFJROTC I and II students will register for AFJROTC III next year
 - Maintains proper course structure, alignment, and enrollment/staffing for 2020-2021





General Considerations

- AMS/CMS revamped for updates, organization, and look
 - Grade level curriculum/course offerings all together
 - Overall grid for middle school programming
- CCP information updated to reflect the same as BHS/FH
- Art, Music, Health/PE Course of Study year - no changes to courses/structure
- Course fees inserted if applicable - consistency with BHS/FH
