### **Reconfirmation Meeting for June 2021**

# Reconfirm how instruction (Return to Learn Plan) is going to be delivered during the 20/21 school year:

Since the approval of the original ECOL Plan in September, PRAS has implemented hybrid days (half-day face-to-face and half-day intermittent/remote) on 11/18, 12/2, 12/9, 12/16, 1/13, 1/27 and similar days on 2/17, 3/3, and 3/24 and will consider future hybrid Wednesdays after examining COVID-19 impacted numbers. At this time, PRAS offers face-to-face instruction in compliance with the Michigan Safe Start Plan, Return to Learn Plan, and Covid-19 Preparedness and Response Plan, Extended Covid-19 Learning Plan, MDHHS executive orders, health department guidelines, and all current state and federal legislation per our submitted and approved process at the Board, ISD, and MDE level.

A parent-friendly, abbreviated version designed to answer questions about procedures and processes should we have to suspend face-to-face learning has been placed on our website as of November 4, 2020.

Also recently approved by the Board and put on our website is the process and procedure for Snow Day Instruction once the district hits Snow Day #7.

The ability to go from face-to-face to Buck Virtual and vice versa for Semester Two went out in October and November.
