2020-2021 South Elementary Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

On in-person learning days, students may **NOT** be dropped off earlier than 8:25 AM. Stoughton Supervisory coverage available until that time. *We are allowing students to enter the building from 8:25 to 8:45. Students are tardy at 8:50.*

The morning drop off procedure works well for the safety of students and the flow of traffic. I wish to alert all that the curb painted yellow is a **drop off only** area. You are not allowed to park. It is a lane in which cars keep flowing in order to not cause a traffic jam. Parents are not to park at the yellow curb in the morning or during afternoon dismissal. From 8:25 to 8:45 am, students <u>exit</u> their cars <u>independently</u> on the <u>right side</u> and enter the building through the determined door. Adults do <u>not</u> get out of the vehicle. Parents must park in a designated parking spot displayed by white lines or white curbing if you wish to walk your child to the door. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Dismissal will begin at 2:35 PM for K and first graders. Students grade 2-5 who are "walkers" or who are "parent pick-ups" will be exiting the building between 2:40 and 2:45. Please let the school know if there is a change in the dismissal routine for your child. If someone other than a parent/guardian will be picking-up your child, please send a note to the school indicating such. We may ask for photo identification if the person is not known to us. *Any change in dismissal or early dismissal requires a note with parent/guardian signature.*

Staff members will be positioned at the appropriate school entrances/exits in order to direct students and to verbally enforce social distancing.
