2021-2022 Safe Return and Continuity of Services Plan

Pioneer Pleasant Vale Public Schools has taken and will continue to take action to ensure the health and safety of all students and staff. A description of actions previously taken and the continuation of health and educational services are provided here. This plan was developed in conjunction with local and state health officials and created with input from school and community members. Our goal is to fully return to school while maintaining procedures that will keep our students and faculty safe.

- Traditional in-person learning will resume for the 2021-22 school year and remain in place as long as COVID-19 infections remain at a level that indicates that in-person learning is safe for students and staff.
- Virtual learning option will only be continued for those students and parents who have special conditions or it is medically necessary.
- Traditional calendar will be observed and can be found at [www.ppv.k12.ok.us](http://www.ppv.k12.ok.us)
- Staff will continue with increased cleaning of school buildings and buses.
- Students and staff will continue to be encouraged to hand wash and have access to hand sanitizers.
- Temperatures may be checked upon entering school buildings. Individuals with symptoms of COVID-19, such as a fever of 100 degrees or more, may not enter.
- Visitor access will be limited. The school board has authorized the administration to change this if conditions change.
- Parents will be contacted if students exhibit symptoms of illness while at school. PPV encourages individuals with COVID symptoms to be tested so that the spread of the virus can be detected and stopped quickly.
- Staff members have received information regarding vaccines.
- Appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities are provided on a case by case basis so that the individual needs of the student may be addressed.
- Face coverings may be required in school/community spread of COVID is high. Please refer to the school board policy regarding masks at [www.ppv.k12.ok.us](http://www.ppv.k12.ok.us)
- Pioneer Pleasant Vale Public Schools will provide summer school and extended school year services if needed. During the school year, students will continue to be assessed, monitored and instructed based on their learning needs. Feedback will be provided to students and parents.
- The district will increase services to address social-emotional learning and mental health needs through partnerships with local counseling organizations.
