#### Hello Children!

The information below will help you and your family get ready for kindergarten.

# Greetings Kindergarten Family!

Over the summer, there are many things that you can do to help prepare your child for kindergarten:

- Build independence with bathroom and dressing routines.
- Build" mask stamina" by having your child "practice" wearing a mask during the day (while reading a book, playing with toys, using a tablet, walking in hallways).
- Practice following 2-Step verbal directions ("first---, then ---").
- Let your child explore using a pencil, pen, scissors, gluesticks, etc.

Here is a list we think you will find helpful as your family prepares for Kindergarten:

- Please plan to send a healthy snack and water bottle each day with your child.
- Please put all notes in the home-school folder (green and white Forest Park folder). Your child is responsible for handing in any notes; please remind him/her to do so.
- Please send your child with 2-3 extra masks each day. Please keep these in a ziploc in your child's backpack.
- If there are any changes with pick-up or child care, we must be notified immediately. Only adults listed in ASPEN are permitted to pick up children from school.
- Please remember to put your child's name on backpacks, lunch boxes, clothing, etc.
- Please return emergency cards as soon as possible. Please reach out to our school nurse (Lisa Meyer;
  lisa meyer@nksd.net) directly if your child has an allergy or medical condition.
- Have your child bring his/her dismissal tag to and from school for the first week. We will provide the dismissal tags at orientation.

## Student Supplies

Please send your child to school with the following items:

- 1 backpack, large enough to hold a lunchbox and standard-sized folder
- 1 full change of clothes (socks, pants, underwear and shirt), clearly labeled in a large ziploc bag. We will keep these on our shelf for emergencies.
- 1 hard-sided pencil box
- Headphones labeled in gallon sized ziploc bag. Please do not send in earbuds.

## Classroom Supply Wishlist (Can be sent in at any time)

- 3 cans of play-doh
- 1 box of gallon-size resealable bags
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes
- 2 containers of anti-bacterial wet wipes for cleaning hands
- 1 box of tissues
- Disposable children's face masks
