Goal #2 Data Update and Accountability Review:

Mr. Stumpf gave a brief reminder to the Board what Kansas Education Systems Accreditation (KESA) is and how our district is working through the plan.

KESA Committee Chairpersons gave the Board of Education an overview of each of their committees taking questions from the Board afterwards.

Enrollment Projections:

Mr. Stumpf provided the Board of Education an update on Kindergarten Roundup and our current projected numbers. He provided them with a statistical analysis of future enrollment at SES for Kindergarten. He will ask the Board of Education for a recommendation at the April meeting whether we increase Kindergarten to three sections for the 2021-22 school year or limit our enrollment and stay at two sections.

Capital Projects:

With the potential rise in metal costs, Mr. Stumpf asked the Board of Education to decide on the shop project as presented.

A motion was made by Dwight Conley and seconded by Jill Ade to accept the bid from Matheson for the metal shop project as presented. Carried 6-0

A motion was made by Steve Bartholomew and seconded by Jill Ade to move forward with Jones Gillam Renz Architects, Inc. to get bid specifications for the frontage and bathroom projects. Carried 6-0
