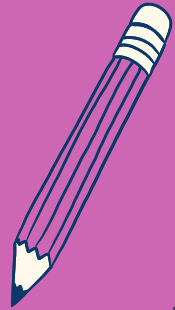


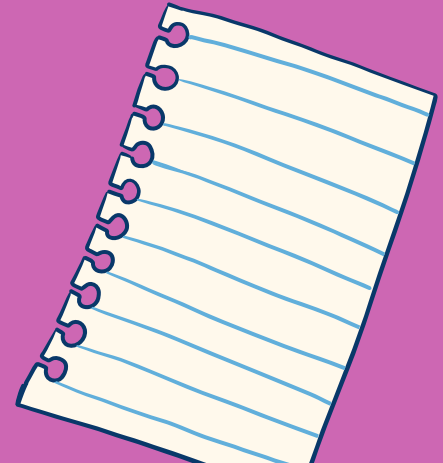

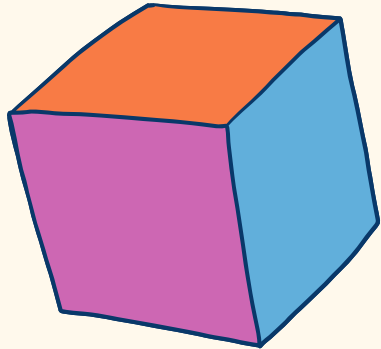
$$X = \frac{-b \pm \sqrt{b^2 - 4ac}}{2a}$$

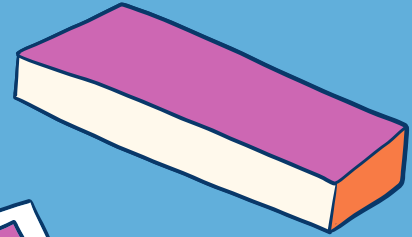

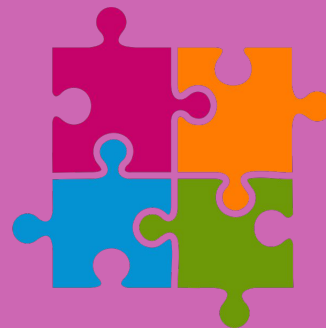
What is Title I ?

- The New Jersey Department of Education sends the money to the districts.
- The school district identifies eligible schools and provides Title I funds.

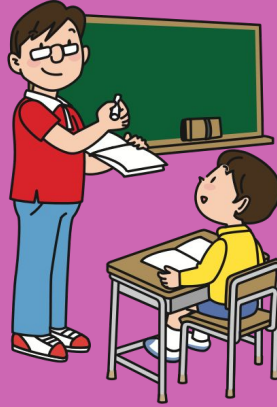
How Title I works

Title I Programs Provide Supplemental Support



- Small Group Setting Pull Out or Push In Assistance
- Additional Basic Skills Teachers
- A variety of supplemental teaching methods and materials
- Programs and Emphasis on Reading, Writing and Mathematical Skills

Student Selection



- Students are selected based on multiple criteria...
- Report Card Grades
- Standardized Testing Scores such as NJSLA
- Benchmark Assessments such as iReady
- Parent/Teacher Recommendation
