## Notice of Right to Know Teacher Qualifications

Parents have the right to know about the teaching qualifications of your child's classroom teacher in a school receiving Title I funds. We are pleased to report that all teachers at James A. Garfield Elementary School have met the Ohio teacher licensing criteria for their respective grade level and subject area. School districts receiving Title I funds must notify parents that they may ask about the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher.

## These qualifications include:

- 1. Whether the teacher has met the Ohio teacher licensing criteria for the grade level and subject area in which the teacher provides your child instruction.
- 2. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or temporary status that waives state licensing requirements.
- 3. Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of their certification.
- 4. Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

Parents may ask for this information by sending a letter of request to Principal Leindecker at James A. Garfield Elementary School, 10207 State Route 88, Garrettsville, Ohio 44231. Be sure to include the following information with your request: child's full name, parent/guardian's full name, address, and teacher's name. The requested information will be provided in timely manner.
