



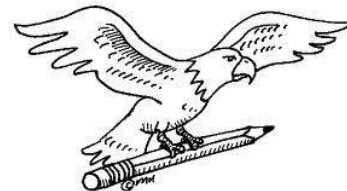

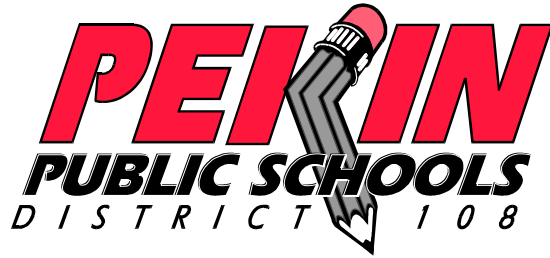

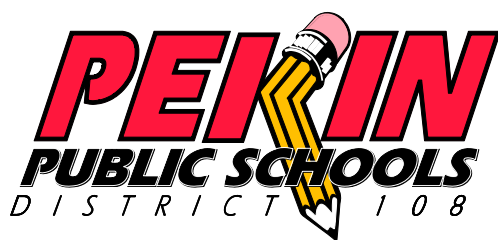

2015 PARCC Results: Each grade level will have an opportunity to view results from the 2015 PARCC. We will be able to view school results compared to district and state scores and each classroom teacher will also receive a copy of their individual student results.

Math Discourse: We will continue our work addressing our school goal in math (Talk Moves and Learning Environment). We will watch grade level videos and then debrief our observations. Also during this session, each classroom teacher will take the winter self-assessment for Math Talk Moves and Math Solutions Learning Environment.

Battling the Winter Blues: Midway through the year we see changes in students' social behaviors. They start exhibiting more socially inappropriate behaviors that affect their relationships amongst their peers and attitudes. The classroom climates can become a bit more tense as well. We would like to revisit some techniques that may be helpful in the classroom environment, and also give some new fresh ideas to teaching staff to tame the tensions.


