

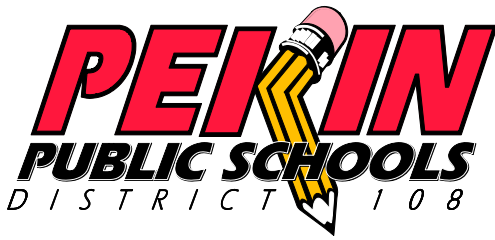

- **PARCC 2018** - How to unlock PARCC sessions prior to their students taking their assessment
- **STAR** - New reports that can be generated using STAR
- **S/E/L** - Updates and general information
- **Student Intervention Planners** - All classroom teachers should update the Student Intervention Planners that were created during Problem Solving meetings in September and January. Winter data and observations should be entered.
- **Data108** - All classroom teachers should use Data108 to enter the names of those students who have / had an Intervention Planner during the 2017-18 school year.
 - Literacy goal - use the F&P Continuum to create / update the RtI plan. STAR is progress monitor
 - Math goal - use classroom assessments, data, observations, etc. to create / update the RtI plan. AimsWeb Plus is the progress monitor
- **PGP Activities** - Use this opportunity to begin working on Self-Reflection (Form H) which is found on the D108 Website (PGP). Also, can use this time to prepare for the self-reflection meeting (PGP evidence for components in Domains 1 & 4)
- **Spring Conferences** - Use this opportunity to put together reports, student work, etc. for those students who you have identified in needing a conference.
- **Curriculum Planning** - use this opportunity to plan for upcoming units, lessons, assessments, reflect on past lessons, tasks, assessments, plan for upcoming events (Math Night, Clean Water, etc.), share with classroom teachers current and upcoming units (Exploratory)
- **Intruder Drill** - Will occur sometime between 1:45 - 3:15. There will be a short debriefing session with the PPD in the Auditorium.
