

Expectation 6. Engage in work with integrity, both independently and collaboratively.

Exceeds Expectation	The student knows and follows the PHS Code of Behavior; demonstrates creativity, insight and originality of thought when producing work; accepts individual differences, respects and responds to the ideas of others constructively, and consistently contributes to the collaborative process; understands the concept of intellectual property and the issues of citation and plagiarism.*
Meets Expectation	The student knows and follows the PHS Code of Behavior; demonstrates originality of thought when producing work; accepts individual differences, respects and responds to the ideas of others constructively, and contributes to the collaborative process; understands the issues of citation and plagiarism.*
Nearly Meets Expectation	The student attempts to follow the PHS Code of Behavior; has difficulty demonstrating originality of thought; may struggle to accept individual differences and respond to the ideas of others; provides limited contribution to the collaborative process; shows little understanding of the issues of citation and plagiarism.
Does Not Meet Expectation	The student shows limited or no understanding of the PHS Code of behavior; shows little to no originality of thought, acceptance of individual differences, or contribution to the collaborative process; does not adhere to rules governing citation and plagiarism.

* “Issues of citation and plagiarism” may include citing sources correctly in the required standard format, both in-text and in a Works Cited.
