

I will be using my 3rd hour class for this SLO. 25 students total. 5 students with IEPs who are supported by Resource Teacher. 2 students in my 3rd hour class come with truancy concerns.

I will be comparing the average rubric score growth from the initial 2 submissions from each student in September to the average of their 2 submissions in the month of January. The rubric looks at the following areas: Annotations, identifying strategies employed, identifying central idea of the text, providing examples from text that supports the central idea, naming text features, and identifying purpose. Highest possible points awarded on the rubric is 12.

7 Describe how the assessment and evaluation procedures will be differentiated to meet the needs of all students described in the student population.

Special ed students will be conferring with both myself and the Resource Teacher. Students who demonstrate limited growth in their writing in the fall will meet more frequently with myself and/or Resource Teacher to encourage and promote growth in their writing and analytical skills.
