

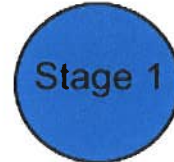
# COVID-19 STANDARD RESPONSE PROTOCOL FOR HART ISD

---

## Prevention

### No confirmed cases of COVID-19 among staff or students.

- Health prevention measures are in place (temp. screenings for all and masks worn by ages 10 and up)
- Daily intensive cleaning and frequent cleaning of common areas
- Limited visitor access
- Monitoring virus trends in the community via health departments
- Designated arrival and dismissal areas to promote social distancing

## Mitigation

### One to two confirmed COVID-19 case(s) in a classroom.

- Affected person(s) will be advised to self-quarantine for 14 days
- Affected area is deep cleaned
- Those in close contact with affected person(s) will be advised to monitor their health.



---

## Modified Operations

### Three or more confirmed COVID-19 cases in a classroom.

- Students and Staff in that classroom will be advised to self quarantine for 14 days.
- Students impacted move to remote learning
- Affected area is deep cleaned
- Self-health monitoring, prevention information and stay home if ill reminders will be distributed to those affected.

## District Closure

### District COVID-19 cases exceed 10% of occupancy in the district.

- All Hart ISD facilities close for a minimum of 14 days.
- Students and staff move to remote learning and work.
- Disinfection of all facilities and school buses.
- All auxiliary areas such as playgrounds and athletic fields are closed.
- Extracurricular activities are cancelled.
