A Letter from Mrs. Walk, Principal

Hello Parents,

We are in that exciting part of the school year where the learning really takes on a new level. We are able to go deeper into the content and move along at a quicker pace. I see students reading at higher lexile levels than when they began the school year, completing increasingly complex math problems, and making new connections with science and social studies topics. None of this would be possible if classroom procedures and behavior expectations were not being met. It all has to align for the deep learning to be able to happen. As an educator, seeing all of these pieces come together makes my heart happy!

As we continue our book study of *The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People*, we move on to Habit 5: Seek First to Understand, Then to Be Understood. In order to do this, we must learn to listen...really listen.

To be an empathic listener, the following strategies are helpful:

- * Take the time. Active, empathic listening requires time.
- * Offer empathy, not sympathy.
- * Pay attention to body language.
- * Refrain from solutions.
- * Use open-ended, empathic, or dangling questions.
- * Ask for more.
- * Repeat a phrase or word.
- * Allow for silences.

The second part of this Habit is to "Be Understood." When we're able to present our ideas clearly, and in the context of a deep understanding of the other person's needs and concerns, we significantly increase the credibility of ideas being shared.

I hope you enjoy these cold days home with your sweet children as you snuggle up and enjoy each other.

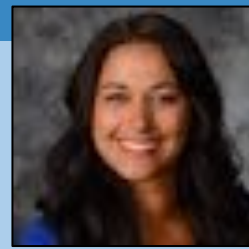

Kindergarten & New to the District First Grade Registration for the 2019-2020 School Year

March 7th 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM

Beavercreek City Schools will conduct a full day registration for all students entering kindergarten and first graders who are new to the district on Thursday, March 7th, at the Board of Education office (3040 Kemp Road) from 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM. No appointments are necessary for this day, but you must complete your new student enrollment information online prior to March 7th. (Student does not need to attend)

Please visit www.gocreek.org/registration/ to begin the online enrollment process. This webpage will direct you to the OneView link where you will create your parent account. After you create your account, select the "New Student Registration" option. Once you have submitted your online enrollment information, please review the required documentation listed below and bring with you on March 7th

Required Documentation:

- 🍏 Original/Certified Birth Certificate, Passport or Birth Record (**no other documents are acceptable**)
- 🍏 Custody documents if applicable (appointing custody, residential parent, etc.)
- 🍏 Adoption paperwork (Birth certificate listing adoptive parents or copy of adoption decree)
- 🍏 Immunization Records
- 🍏 Parent/Guardian **must** provide government issued I.D.
- 🍏 Proof of Residence (**DP&L, Vectren or Water bill, not more than 60 days old – No other bills are acceptable**)
 - A new rental/lease agreement signed by the parent/guardian **and** the person or company renting the property can be used for initial registration (lease in effect for less than 45 days); however, a utility bill must be provided to the student's school within 30 days of enrollment.
 - A Residence Affidavit is required if the student meets any of the following criteria:
 - Student is 18 years of age or older and is living with someone, other than parent/guardian, within the district.
 - Student (less than 18 years of age) and parent/guardian are living with a family member or friend who resides within the district.
 - A Superintendent Agreement form is required if any of the following criteria applies:
 - Parent/Guardian is in the process of building, purchasing or renting a home and is not physically residing at the address until after the registration process; a signed purchase contract or lease is **still required** and must show the approximate move in date.

Kindergarten: Your child must be five years old on or before August 1st of the year in which he/she applies

First Grade (Newly Enrolling): Your child must be six years old on or before August 1st, of the year in which he/she applies and must successfully complete kindergarten at an accredited program and be recommended by the teacher for advancement to the first grade

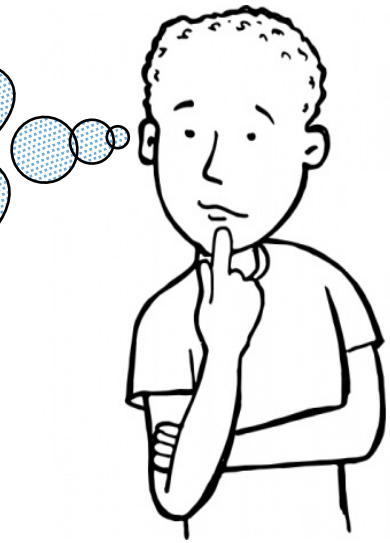

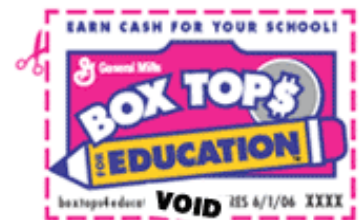
