- 2. After our first meet, we embraced the theme: Little Things Matter.
- 3. The Zion Track team has 28 students, grades 5-8. Over half the team is made up of 5/6 graders. It was intimidating for many of our athletes lining up against kids a foot taller with full-grown mustaches and permed mullets. We knew we were little, but together we knew we were strong.
 - Competed in five invitational (4 scored meets) with an average of 11 participating teams; each athlete was competing against an average of 45 other athletes.
 - Overall, the girls claimed a 1st and 3rd place finish in Wilcox and Alma.
 - In Fremont (one team had 100 5/6 grade participants!)
 - 5/6 grade girls claimed a 5th place finish (6 total girls)
 - 7/8 grade girls claimed a 3rd place finish (4 total girls)
 - 5/6 grade boys claimed a 4th place finish (4 total boys)
 - 7/8 grade boys claimed a 5th place finish (8 total boys)
 - As a team, we won 62 medals with an average placement of third.
 - Four 7/8 Grade girls will participate in the Middle School State Track Meet tomorrow in Gothenburg.
 - o 4 x 4 Relay team (Abigail Burger, Makenna Starkey, Lauren Starkey, Blaire May) Ranked #9 in State.
 - o Abigail Burger will run the 1600 and the 800; Ranked #3 and #2

- The rest of the team will compete in the All Lutheran Championship at Concordia tomorrow.
 - o 5/6 grade boys and girls have 4 records they are within reach of breaking tomorrow.
