It is strongly suggested that younger students start looking at and purchasing Chromebooks for their own use both in the classroom and in the event that we, as a school, are forced to switch from in-person learning to eLearning in the course of the school year.

Student devices which are not Chromebooks, **will not** be added to the wireless network. Any replacement devices and devices of students new to the LSA must be Chromebooks. This is what works best for our school and our students.
