



2021-22 Registration Information

New Students:

To register in the Teutopolis Community Unit 50 School District, new students must have the following:

Forms for transfer of records will be available, but it would help if you took care of this earlier. We need the records to schedule your child in the correct classes. If you wait until registration, it is possible the records will not be received in time to correctly schedule your child. Please call the school office to obtain these forms. These forms will also include more new student requirements—such as verification of residency, etc.

Dress Code:

The wearing of shorts at all Unit 50 schools is permissible for the months of August, September, October, April and May. Please check the Handbook to make sure your student's attire meets the standards of dress set by the district dress code. The fingertip rule will be implemented.

Reminder: Attention TGS Parents: For safety reasons, the wearing of flip-flops or strapless sandals is no longer allowed for grade school students (Preschool through 6th grade). Please help your children select shoes appropriate and safe for physical activity at recess and in PE class, as well as getting on and off the school bus.

Parents of Graduated Special Ed Students:

The Illinois State Archives recommends destroying special education records five years after the student has graduated or permanently withdrawn from school. The special education records of students who attended Teutopolis Unit 50 school district in Teutopolis, IL who were born before 1996 will be disposed of in November 2021. Pesticide Spraying:

We are continuing our pesticide spraying program in Unit 50. Our pesticide provider, Arrow Pesticide Control, has assured us that the routine pesticides they use in our schools are safe and low in odor. We do this spraying when the students are not present to allow sufficient time for drying. These pesticides are the same ones that they use in hospitals and nursing homes. If, for some reason, it is necessary for a more extensive spray, you may request to put your name on a list to be informed two days before this takes place. If you are interested in this, just call your school office to be notified ahead of time.

Athletic/Activity Participation Fee

Reminder: The Board of Education has adopted an athletic/activity participation fee per season for each student in each sport. The fee is \$75.00 for junior high and high school students. (Bass Fishing remains at \$25.00.) It is non-refundable and non-transferable. The fee, payable to Teutopolis Unit 50, may be paid in the Junior High School Office for junior high students and in the High School Office for high school students. The fee payment may also be given to the respective coaches in the sport which the athlete is participating. Fee must be paid prior to the first contest of the particular season in which the athlete is competing. No student will be allowed to participate in any contests until his/her fee has been paid.

Non-Athletic/Activity Participation Fee

Reminder: The Board of Education has adopted a \$5.00 non-athletic/activity participation fee for each student in each club.

2021-22 Illinois SCHOOL HEALTH Requirements/Info

PHYSICAL EXAM

A physical examination is required for entry into preschool, kindergarten, sixth, and ninth grades. The exam must be completed within one year of entering school at the required grade (Example: for the school year 2021-22, the physical must be dated after September 1, 2020).

The physical can be performed by a physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice nurse.

1. A student is considered to be in compliance when they have submitted the appropriate documentation for the physical and immunizations required for their grade.
2. Students who are not compliant with physical or immunizations by October 15th of the school year are subject to exclusion from school until the appropriate documentation has been submitted.

IMMUNIZATIONS

1. All immunizations must be completed before the start of school and proof of immunizations must be presented to the school office before the first day of school.
2. See attached table for schedule of required immunizations.

VISION EXAM

1. All students enrolling in kindergarten and students enrolling in an Illinois school for the first time (public, private, or parochial) must submit an eye exam. The requirement does not apply to preschool students.
2. The exam must be completed by an optometrist or ophthalmologist.



DENTAL EXAM

1. Children entering Kindergarten, 2nd, 6th and 9th grades are required to submit a dental exam form.
2. The exam must be completed by a licensed dentist.
3. Proof of exam must be submitted by May 15th.
4. The exam must have taken place within 18 months prior to May 15th (Example: For the May 15, 2022 deadline, the exam can be dated after Nov. 15, 2020).

New students enrolling in an Illinois school for the first time will be required to obtain a physical examination, vision exam, and provide up-to-date immunization record regardless of grade.

Reminder, this was NEW for 2016... the religious exemption form for shots. It must be filled out by the student's doctor and turned in to the office at registration. The form is located on the school webpage under Parents, Student Health Forms & Info.
