Your child is confirmed for the online educational option for the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year. The online educational commitment form you completed is for one semester only in the school year 2020 - 2021. If your child wishes to continue his/her participation in this online educational option for the second semester of 2020 - 2021, an additional commitment form must be submitted by November 30, 2020. The second semester registration form must be completed by December 9, 2020.

Course Registration

As you make your course selections, please consider the original course level placements that were recommended for your child and ensure required prerequisites have been met in order to enroll in a course. After you submit your registration form, a counselor will review the course selections to ensure students are registered for courses that are both appropriate for their skill level/prior course work and meet the expectations for their grade level and/or graduation requirements (seniors only). If there are any questions or concerns regarding the courses selected, counselors will reach out to students and/or families.

Registration Requirements

- Grades 6-8 must register for at least 6 courses.
- Grade 9-11 must register for 6 courses and those required to meet graduation requirements.
- Grade 12 must register for courses needed to meet graduate requirements.

School Fees

At this time, we are not aware of any fees associated with the online program. However, if there are any specific fees for any courses, we will communicate that information to you as soon as we receive it. If your child returns for second semester, fees will be prorated.

<u>Teacher Student Advocate (TSA)</u>

Since the deadline to choose an educational option has passed, the buildings are busy finalizing schedules. Once this is complete, we will determine which teachers will serve as TSA's in each

building. The TSAs will receive training on the online platform. During the first week of school, you will be contacted by your child's TSA.

Schedule

Our online school calendar mirrors our traditional school calendar, which is as follows:

- August 14 21: Staff training, professional development, classroom preparation
- August 24: Staggered start date for students A-K / Start date for ALL online students
- August 25: Staggered start date for students L-Z
- August 26: All students report
- October 12: Students report for school
- Mid-November: Families will be asked to choose online or traditional education for the second semester
- February 12: Students report to school
- May 24: Class of 2021 Graduation at the Nutter Center, 7:00 p.m.
- May 28: Last day for students and staff, two-hour early dismissal

Students will still receive their original 178 days of instruction during the year and it is important to note that Fall Break (November 23-27), Winter Break (December 21 - January 1), and Spring Break (March 22-26) will take place as originally scheduled.
