REGULAR USD 251 BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

March 6, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.

1. OPENING ITEMS:

The regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Matt Horton in the BOE meeting room in Americus. **BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT:**

2. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA WITH CONSENT ITEMS AS FOLLOWS:

Angela Anderson (Tim Burton) moved to approve the agenda with consent items as follows, moving item 6.a. Superintendent search to 2.c. Motion passed. (4-2, Maxfield M., Reed T.)

- b. Approval of expenditures from February 1 28, 2018
- c. 6.a. Superintendent search:

Craig Wilford from KASB offered to help with the Superintendent search. This service is at no cost to the district. He proposed hiring an interim Superintendent for 2 years, based on rationales someone with experience would be fitting. The plan is to start interviews within a couple of weeks. Mr. Wilford asked the board to complete a short survey to help him have a better understanding of the type of Superintendent the district is looking for. Within the next week each BOE member shall submit 5 interview questions to the Clerk. The Board will have to decide what the interview day will look like. Special meetings will be scheduled.

3. COMMUNICATION TO AND FROM THE BOARD:

a. Report of Clerk:

The clerk handed out mail.

b. Report of President:

The President sends his thoughts and prayers to the Galloway family. He further said that busy times are ahead for the BOE, big decisions will have to be made.

David Goldsmith Jr. pointed out that a fellow board member was recording the meeting without stating the fact at the beginning of the meeting. Tammie Reed admitted she is recording it for personal reasons. Clerk will check with KASB on legality of such recordings.

c. Report of Superintendent:

The Superintendent sends thoughts and prayers to the Galloway family and announced funeral services. He further said that the Gemini project will be put on hold for the remainder of the school year, hopefully will start back up next year. He reported from the KansansCan Symposium and spoke of the snow days that will need to be made up.

4. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:

Reta Jackson said schools belong in communities. Closing a school won't fix what is wrong with the district. She challenges the BOE to represent the patrons and children of the entire district.

John Maxfield spoke of safety and security in our schools and feels that something needs to be done.

Gary Heine said trust is very important. Saying that during the last bond the BOE stated that no school will be closed, 90 days later their closing a school. He also said there is no shame on voting no.

Nancy Wells commended the BOE for wanting to fix things and moving forward. Admire school needed to be closed because of the buildings state, Reading school needs to be closed because of inefficiencies.

Evan Wilson spoke on declining rural population. He said that there are families here, new families have moved into the district. He feels that the school needs to be where the population is.

The President said that the district is looking at ways to evaluate and work on the security in our buildings.

a. Investment grade audit:

Tim Burton (Angela Anderson) moved to approve P1 Group to do an investment grade audit. Motion passed. (6-0) P1 Group will perform the audit. If BOE acts on any of the proposed items, the audit will be free. Shall the BOE decide not to act on any proposals, the audit will cost \$7,000.

Tim Burton (Angela Anderson) moved to approve the following date, time, and location for the public hearing for the closure of Reading School. Wednesday, March 28th, 2018 at 7 p.m. in the Board of Education Meeting Room in Americus, KS. Motion passed. (4-2, Reed T., Maxfield M.)

c. Intent to negotiate letter:

Matt Horton, Angela Anderson, and Aron Dody will meet to determine this year's intent to negotiate letter. Letter is due by March 31st each year.

6. NEW BUSINESS:

a. Superintendent search:

b. Board vacancy:

Angela Anderson (David Goldsmith Jr) moved to approve the publication of the board vacancy notice. Interviews of interested applicants will be conducted during the meeting, in open session on April 25th, 2018. Motion passed. (6-0)
