Children must be eligible for the Illinois Vaccine for Children Program (VFC).

### VFC eligibility requirements are:

18 and younger

Enrolled in Medicaid Title 19 & Title 21

Uninsured

Underinsured

Staff will verify eligibility before the appointment is scheduled and on the day of the appointment. Children must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian with proof of legal guardianship or have a written consent by parent.

# Help Is Here

## Monthly payments for families with kids

Raising kids can be expensive, and the Child Tax Credit is here to help. President Biden's American Rescue Plan increased the amount of the 2021 Child Tax Credit to support families with children.

The full benefit of the Child Tax Credit is now \$300 per month per child under age 6 and \$250 for each child age 6 to 17.

**Did you file taxes in the last 2 years? Then you don't have to do anything to get the money you're already owed!**

If you filed your 2020 taxes this year or filed your 2019 taxes last year, or used the IRS "Non-Filer Portal" to get a stimulus check last year, you don't need to do anything. The IRS will automatically send you a monthly payment by direct deposit or check starting on July 15, 2021.

**The Child Tax Credit is \$3,000 to \$3,600 per child with advanced monthly payments.**

In order to get money to families quickly, the IRS will pay half of the credit as monthly payments now and the other half when you file your taxes next year. In total, you'll receive a total of \$3,600 for each child under 6 and \$3,000 for each child between 6 and 17.

**Didn't file taxes in the last 2 years? There's 1 easy step to start getting your Child Tax Credit payments.**

Just fill out a simple form to begin receiving your monthly Child Tax Credit payments. You can access it by going to [childtaxcredit.gov](https://childtaxcredit.gov)

**You'll need this information to apply:**

- Social Security Numbers for you and your children
- A reliable mailing address
- E-mail address
- Your bank account information (if you want to receive your payment by direct deposit)

**Eligibility:** Most families, even those with little to no income, can receive the full amount. If you are a single parent making less than \$112,500 or a married couple making less than \$150,000—and have children under age 18 who will live with you for more than half of 2021—you are likely eligible for the full benefit. These benefits do not affect your eligibility for other federal benefits like SNAP.

# Illinois Health Requirements

## By Grade Level

### Kindergarten or first entry to Illinois schools

1. Physical Exam
2. Immunization record including the following immunizations:
  - 4 DTP (last shot on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
  - 3 Polio (last shot on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
  - 2 MMR (1<sup>st</sup> dose on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday)
  - Varicella (chicken pox; 1<sup>st</sup> dose on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday)
3. Dental Exam on school dental exam form
4. Vision Exam by optometrist or ophthalmologist

### Second Grade

1. Dental Exam on school dental exam form

### Sixth Grade

1. Physical Exam
2. Dental Exam
3. Immunizations including:
  - 3 HBV (hepatitis B)
  - Tdap booster
  - Meningococcal vaccine

### Ninth Grade

1. Physical Exam
2. Dental Exam

### Twelfth Grade

1. Immunization: 2<sup>nd</sup> meningococcal vaccine required by entrance to school

*5th - 8th Student Athletes - need a current physical on file to play sports. Physicals need to be on file BEFORE the sport begins! 6th grade requirements above meet sports physical requirements. No need for two separate ones.*
