We are so excited to have our teachers and students back in our buildings! They are learning, interacting and cheering on their Tiger teams!

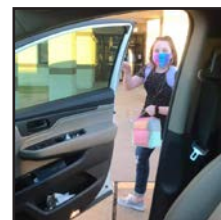
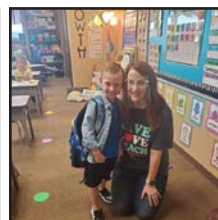
The 2020-21 school year is off to a great start! Even though we are having to wear masks to teach and learn, our spirits are high because we are **SO GLAD** to be back in school!

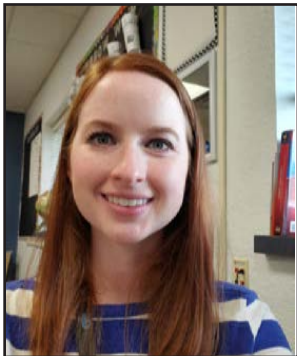

Keep Our Kids Safe!



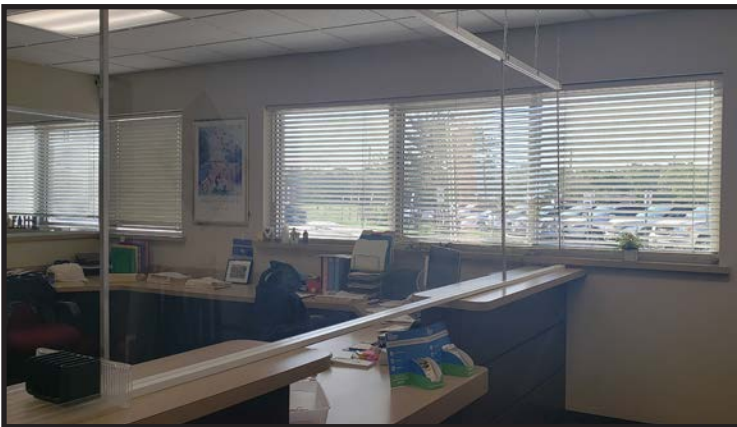

- 🚌 When driving on our campuses, watch for students walking through the parking lots and **do not drive in areas that are not permitted**.

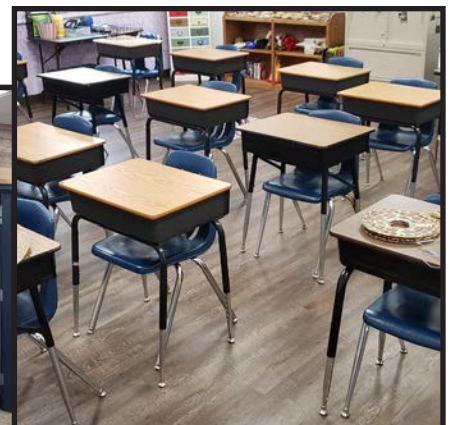
The Gunter Volunteer Fire & Rescue would like us to remind you to **keep our fire lanes clear**.

The Special meeting was called to order by Scott Meyerdirk, Board President. A quorum was established.

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

- Communications
 - 2020-2021 Budget Presentation: Dr. Siler presented a draft budget for the 2020-21 school year.
 - COVID-19 Report: Dr. Siler shared the final Back-to-School Plan.

- The Board approved the 2020-2021 Teacher Salary Schedule and Employee Compensation Package that included a 2.5% raise for all staff based on the midpoint of each employee classification.
