

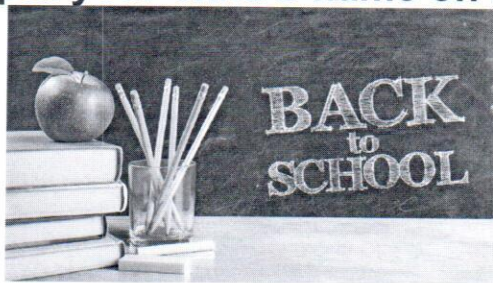
**First Grade School Supplies
