Middle Level General Core Requirements

A. The following are the General Core Requirements for the 7th Grade

- Grade 7 Language Arts (3 trimesters)
- Grade 7 Mathematics (3 trimesters)
- Grade 7 Integrated Science (3 trimesters)
- Utah Studies (1 trimester)
- The Arts (1 trimester)
- Physical Education (1 trimester)
- College and Career Awareness (3 trimesters)

B. The following are the General Core Requirements for the 8th Grade

- Grade 8 Language Arts (3 trimesters)
- Grade 8 Mathematics (3 trimesters)
- Grade 8 Integrated Science (3 trimesters)
- United States History (2 trimesters)
- The Arts (1 trimester)
- Physical Education (1 trimester)
- Health Education (1 trimester)
- Digital Literacy (1 trimester)

- C. Based on competency, a student who does not successfully complete any of the Core Requirements may be assigned to participate in remediation programs, intervention sessions and/or an approved individualized plan. Fees may be charged for programs outside of the regular school day.
- D. Parents will be notified if a student does not successfully complete the Core Requirements and/or demonstrate competency prior to promotion to the next grade level.
- E. Board-approved summative adaptive assessments shall be used to assess student mastery of the following: reading, language arts, mathematics, and science.
- F. Upon parental or student request (with parental consent), courses listed above may be substituted with a course, extracurricular activity, or experience that is similar to the course requirement and is consistent with the student's plan for college and career readiness. Requests for substitution must be made prior to the beginning of each school

year to the school counselors. Should a request for substitution be denied, a parent may appeal the decision to the school principal.
