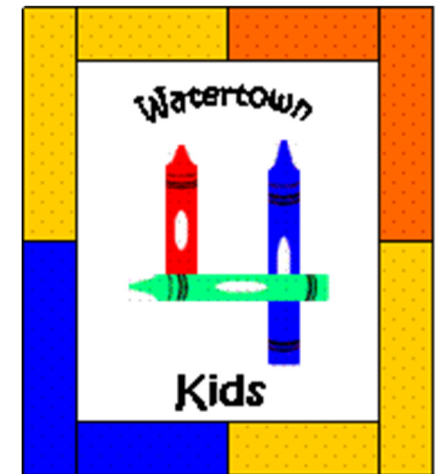

WHAT WILL MY CHILD LEARN

- Children will participate in play-based developmentally appropriate activities and that provide rich learning experiences, taught by highly qualified Wisconsin Department of Instruction licensed teachers.
- A focus on learning through play allows children to gain skills in all areas including: social-emotional, cognitive, creative expression, early literacy and self-help.
- Children in the Watertown 4 Kids Program will learn positive values with an emphasis on character education. This would include integrating life lessons on trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship.

HOW DO I APPLY?

- Enrollment begins online at www.watertown.k12.wi.us.
- After completing the online enrollment process, you will have ten business days to complete the process at Schurz Elementary between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3:45 p.m. You will need to provide your child's birth certificate or hospital record to verify birthdate and turn in immunization information.

- Parents will list their 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choice preference on the application. Every effort will be made to secure the best placement for your child.
