ATTENDANCE

Chairman Noyes called the meeting to order at 6:08pm and allowed for public comment.

CALL TO ORDER

Ed Shindoll reported on bus maintenance. He stated there were no major problems this year, but he would like to service the two big buses before fall.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Shane stated the asbestos abatement started on June 1, 2021. Shane reported on the completion of phase one and the start of phase two. Shane stated the excavation of the old building is complete and was hauled off. Shane also stated the construction crew is ready to start pouring slabs. Jason stated ESSER funds may be used for some mechanical equipment in the school.

ELEMENTARY BUILDING PROJECT

Shane stated they are working on the design documents for the roof. It will be put out to bid in the fall.

HAIL DAMAGE CLAIM INFORMATION

Erik stated in order to apply for ESSER funds we need to have a Safe Return to School and Continuity of Services Plan. The plan would need to be adopted and put on the school's website by June 24, 2021. Erik stated the school would need a plan to keep the school open to the best of our ability. Erik stated a special board meeting will be held on June 22, 2021 to put the plan in place.

COVID-19 RESPONSE PLAN

Kevin McDonnell reported on the meeting between the Teacher's Union and the Negotiations Committee. They made rules on how to submit changes to the agreement. Article 1 establishes a process for collective bargaining and talks about good faith bargaining. If either side wants to make changes it is done through a proposal process in order to streamline the process. A section was added for people that are caught in a situation beyond their control to receive additional
